#### 1996 Château Lagrange, St-Julien ......\$39.99

90-91 points from Robert Parker: "A classic Bordeaux as well as a textbook St. Julien... The dark purple color is accompanied by a nose that reluctantly offers up aromas of sweet toasty oak, cassis, cedar, and minerals. Full body and fine concentration, as well as an overall sense of elegance and equilibrium."

#### 1997 Château Gruaud-Larose, St-Julien ......\$34.99

Robert Parker: "Will provide delicious as well as surprisingly complex, savory drinking for a decade." (04/00) Lots of earth and quite chunky on the palate. Cinammon and spicy currants dominate the flavor profile.

#### 1998 Dame de Montrose, St-Estèphe.....\$17.99

This second wine of Montrose is quite rich and full-flavored. Aromas of cassis, cigar box, and ripe currant fruit with a lush mouthfeel, and a lovely, focused finish. Enjoy from 2004 to 2008.

#### 1999 Château Branaire-Ducru, St-Julien ......\$29.99

88-90 points from Parker: "...The dark ruby/purple-colored 1999 exhibits medium to full body, a fat, supple-textured personality, excellent flavor ripeness, and an opulent mouth-feel. This successful effort will drink well upon release, and last for 15 years."

#### 1999 Château Cantenac-Brown, Margaux .....\$27.99

88-89 points Robert Parker: "Potentially the best Cantenac-Brown produced in 2-3 decades, the dense ruby/purple-colored 1999 exhibits a sweet bouquet of black fruits intertwined with licorice, spice box, fennel, and graphite. Full-bodied and rich, with sweet tannin, low acidity, excellent delineation as well as length, and an impressive, expansive, pure mid-palate, it will be drinkable between 2004-2018."

#### 2000 Reserve de Léoville-Barton, St-Julien ......\$24.99

Here is the "sleeper" of the bunch. If you liked 2000 Pagodes de Cos or Réserve de Comtesse, you will love this wine. Jancis Robinson waxed poetic about it in *Decanteur* magazine. You can get five bottles of this baby Léoville for the price of one grand vin! Trust Clyde on this; buy it now and enjoy in five to ten years.

## Jeff's Picks: Spotlight, Rheingau Kabinett

In the vintage of 2002 nature smiled down her radiant glow upon the Rheingau, warming the soils and bathing the vines with life-giving sunlight. Bud break was early, the vines having an almost full two weeks head start. Vegetation was prolific, resulting in a large and healthy canopy to supply the ensuing grapes with photosynthetic power to get underway. The weather held (for the most part), and the Riesling had a long and slow ripening period in which to build flavor and nuance and yet retain acidity. Herein lies the beauty. Think of a male ballet dancer—strong and lithe, gracefully and powerful, light and seemingly weightless in his movements. Now you have a picture of great Rheingau Kabinett. The best take all these components and

bring them to bear in your glass and on your palate with acuity and grace. If you think that Mikhail Baryshnikov at 55 still has his chops, then put a case or two of these wines in your cellar and see what the mellowing of time brings to these regal beauties.

2002 Staatsweinguter Kloster Eberbach Steinberger Kabinett

**(\$13.99)** The famous walled vineyard planted in the early 1200s by the Cistercian monks of the Kloster Eberbach and the crown jewel of the Staatswein domain produces wines of subtlety and elegance. Flowery and spicy with just a hint of sweet woodruff and quince.

**2002 Weingut Spreitzer Oestricher Lenchen Kabinett (\$18.99)** Pure fruit and pleasure is how I would describe this wine. I smile every time I drink it, and you will, too. The Speitzers are on the ups, and this wine shows you why. Filled with orange rind and apricots, peach, sweet herbs and stone with a vibrant racy structure. Also 92 points from the *Wine Spectator*.

**2002** Freiherr Langwerth von Simmern Erbacher Marcobrunn Kabinett (\$16.99) The most "serious" of the three, very concentrated, still young and unevolved but with power and presence. A regal wine from the justly famous Marcobrunn vineyard, filled with apricot, dried flowers, sweet plum and a touch of waxy honeyed richness.

## From the Desk of Ralph Sands: the 2002 Bordeaux Hit List

In the vintage of 2002 there are some great wines, many of which are the same style as the 2000s. These are complex, powerful Cabernet Sauvignon-dominated wines with dark fruit, high acids and high tannin levels—classic Bordeaux that will develop for many years.

Four months ago I emailed many of you about the one wine I would buy first and most of in 2002, and that wine was Cos d'Estournel (was \$53.99) from St-Estèphe. That wine today sells for \$99.99! On my hit list of wines, doubling of price will most likely not happen, but these wines are very good and might even end up in the great category. Please note, these are my personal notes and comments from my palate only. All the wines listed received a star from me, as that is my scoring system for barrel samples.

Ch. Lafite-Rothschild (Inquire) This wine just blows me away! Perfect ripeness, sweet fruit, and a combination of strength, balance, lushness, great mouth feel. The tannins melt in your mouth. Lafite will drink a bit earlier than Latour and Mouton. The 2nd wine Carraudes is also just fantastic and a bit softer. 3 Stars\*\*\*

Ch. Latour (Inquire) and Ch. Mouton-Rothschild (Inquire) Both wines are very long distance runners, no surprise. Both wines 2 Stars\*\* The fragrant nose of Latour—roses, raspberries and earth all at a high point, very expansive and fresh. Strong and bright, very deep, full of spice, dark raspberry-type fruit with hints of leather surrounded by fine tannin integration and definition. The second wine Les Forts is also a heck of a deal! ... Mouton is just bursting at the seams in all areas. Loaded with huge amounts of dark red fruit with full throttle tannins to back it up, but they are in good control.

Ch. Cos d'Estournel (\$99.99) No question the superstar of the commune and another great, great wine in 2002. Outside of the first growths, this is the wine of the vintage. Grapey, full of spice, very rich, almost thick and covers all areas of the mouth. Very long on the finish, great wine! 3 Stars\*\*\* The Cos vineyard at the southern border of St-Estèphe butts right up against the vineyard of Lafite-Rothschild at the northern border of Pauillac.

Ch. Pontet-Canet (\$29.95) The purity and perfect ripeness of this big wine is just lovely. It is stern and full with very good tannin integration. It looks to me like the best overall wine for the money of the entire vintage. \* +

**Ch. Pichon Longueville-Baron (\$42.99)** In the last few years winemaker Jean-Rene Matignon and his team have propelled the wine to its greatest heights and should now be included in every conversation and purchase of Bordeaux's best.

Ch. Branaire-Ducru (Inquire) Patrick Maroteau is making beautiful, silky, red fruit dominated wine with flavors of cassis/Bing cherry and showing great purity. This wine is so tasty, classy and elegant, it will drink well young and throughout its life. \*+

Ch. Léoville-Poyferré (\$29.99) Poyferré is a touch bigger wine than Branaire, but similar in the fact that they both have lovely mouth feel while being elegant and polished.

## Love at first taste!

How can a great wine region sometimes seem larger than life? As said by the legendary Jean Michel Cazes, "because Bordeaux is more than just a bottle of wine, but a way of life. It's sitting around a table with friends, breaking bread, and enjoying life while drinking a bottle of Bordeaux." Bordeaux represents an artistic signature similar to that of great painters and composers. Just like a Rembrandt, or a symphony by Beethoven, these are works of art that transport you to another place. That is exactly what Bordeaux wine does without the airfare.

We have four examples that express the essence of Bordeaux: 2000 Cantemerle (\$29.99) is a wine with a license to thrill! Opulent, intense, with aromas of bright plum and chocolate. With a rich and round texture, it's a true treasure! 2000 Arnauld (\$17.99) is a high-speed wine that boasts power, yet is soft enough to appreciate today, with aromas of violets, coffee bean and currants. 2000 Beaumont (\$15.99) is the cowboy of the bunch: tough, unpretentious, and not especially shy about performing in front of a crowd with aromas of dark berries, and tons of fruit on the mid palate. 1997 Poujeaux (\$23.99) is a wine everyone should stock up on. This is fantastic wine from a drink-me-now vintage. Classic Bordeaux nose of red currant, mint and lots of elegance. Purchase this by the case and you still feel you didn't pay enough. I hope you enjoy the essence and soon begin to live the lifestyle that is called Bordeaux. -Gregory Condes

## Poolside Sippers for December!

I noticed that in last month's newsletter, almost every article mentioned wines we all thought would go well with Thanksgiving dinner. I am guessing that this month all of our recommendations will be "wines to go with your Christmas dinner" or "wines to enjoy over the holidays." Well not me. This month I will mix things up and give you my favorite "Poolside Sippers." Generally a poolside sipper is a light and refreshing white to help one cope with hot summer days. Being that it is December, I think we will need some wines with a little more kick! For example, the 2002 Easton **Amador Zinfandel (\$10.99)** is a perfect December poolside sipper! This wine shows tons of rich and ripe fruit, hints of coco and spice, and a smooth, lush finish. How about the 2001 Babcock **Santa Barbara Syrah (\$19.99)!** This wine is big, dark and chunky with heady, dense fruit and spicy, meaty aromas. Loaded with fruit, balanced and not alcoholic, the Babcock is a joy to drink. The 2001 Runquist "Z" Amador Zinfandel (\$18.99) is produced from century-old vines grown on the Massoni Ranch in Amador County. These gnarled old vines produce grapes with an intensity that translates into a depth of flavor rarely achieved in wines from younger stock. A long time favorite of mine, the 2002 Justin Paso Robles "Obtuse" (\$11.99, 375ml) is a late harvest Cabernet Sauvignon that goes perfectly with chocolate desserts. Sweet and ripe, the fruit explodes from the glass and fills your mouth with flavors of blackberries and jam. Enjoy any of these fine wines while sitting next to your pool this December and, hey, forget about the sunblock for once! —Trey Beffa

## Holidays Bubbles from California

What's the difference between sparkling wine and Champagne? Sparkling wine is any wine with CO<sup>2</sup> either naturally occurring or added, and Champagne is the natural version that comes from Champagne, France. In California there are many wines made in the natural "Champenois" method. I have chosen a few for your holiday pleasure.

From Anderson Valley in Mendocino County, Roederer Estate, owned by the Champagne house Louis Roederer, crafts some of the best and most consistent sparkling wines in California. Their **NV Roederer Estate (\$16.99)** is bright and refreshing with green apple and citrus peel fruit, lively acidity and persistent bubble, and a nice toasty character. This is just the thing to have around for any occasion. For a more special treat, their Tête de Cuvée, the **1998 Roederer Estate L'Ermitage (\$29.99)** is rich, broad and intense, showing a long palate of golden baked apple, honey, wet hay and a deep lees component. This is a powerful and complex wine with great balance and finesse.

The most prominent and prestigious sparkling producer in California has to be Schramsberg. These wines have long graced the tables of presidents, socialites and movie stars and are featured on the lists of great restaurants everywhere. In 1965 Schramsberg made the first domestic Chardonnay-based sparkler, the direct descendant of which is the 1999 Schramsberg Blanc de Blanc (\$23.99). A bold presence, impressive, long and fulfilling dried apple and golden honey flavors blossom on the palate. Two years later, they took another domestic leap with the Pinot Noir-based Blanc de Noirs. The 1999 Schramsberg Blanc de Noirs (\$23.99) shows a much richer palate of fruit, red apples, apple pie, light notes of cherry and cinnamon and an oaky touch combine to perfection. This is a more masculine style that will compliment a variety of dishes. Try these pillars of California winemaking this holiday season, you'll be glad you did! —Shaun Green

#### San Francisco Focus

It's December, and those Christmas parties are about to begin. Here are a few wines that are reasonably priced and sure to make your guests happy:

**Gloria Ferrer Brut NV (\$12.99)** Great nose and nice richness for such an inexpensive sparkler. Apple flavors and plenty of toast. It's user-friendly and pleasant. The legendary Spanish sparkling wine producer, Freixenet established Gloria Ferrer in the Carneros region of California.

**2001 Heitz Napa Chardonnay (\$12.99)** From a winery known for its superb Cabernets comes a super buy in California Chardonnay! Clean, fresh, with a hint of oak to balance the wine on the palate. This is food-friendly Chardonnay.

**2001 Vino Noceto Sangiovese (\$11.99)** This is a fruit-packed, easy-drinking red that's ideal with a variety of food. 100% sangiovese, with medium body, cherry-red color, and dark cherry flavors, accented by subtle oak and a dash of peppery spice.

**2002 A to Z Pinot Noir (\$16.99)** This is a beautiful Willamette Pinot Noir that shows beautiful cherry fruit in balance with Oregon earthiness and exotic spice on the finish.

My personal K&L top gift-giving choice!

Next is the **2000 Clos Mimi "Bunny Slope" Syrah (\$49.99)**. Beware. Not for the inexperienced wine drinker, this one is for all the "double black diamond" sippers for sure! Dense, hearty, chewy and supple—all the big wine descriptors are perfect for this Syrah. Parker gave this 90 points. This is a perfect pick for an eclectic wine drinker.

The **2000 Cloverdale Ranch Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon** (\$18.99) has produced more smiles for K&L customers than I can possible describe this year! After suggesting a bottle, the next thing I know, my customer is calling me for a full case! It's a perfect everyday house wine and an incredibly well-priced cabernet that's often poured at company events and private parties. Delicious cherry, cassis and spicy mocha flavors, very little oak as well. Easy drinking!

The **2001 Mantra Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon (\$19.99)** means value, value, value! I took one sip of this and couldn't believe the price of this lush cab! Intense, structured, beautiful dark black cherry fruit and supple oak flavors. A perfect stocking stuffer!

Pollo!") and drinking 13 raw eggs (notice a theme here?) blended with an old cabernet or Bordeaux or sometimes a killer old Port.

Back to the story: The bell rings, and amid the pandemonium (I use to play one of those things, could never tune it) the epic battle begins. Mikey, Rocky's trainer and the only constant in his life with an I.Q. in the triple digits, yells encouragement from the sidelines. "Encouragement! Encouragement!" Low triple digits, apparently, but he has a dream: The winner's share of wine.

## Jim's Winter Wonderland of Christmas Gems

As I write this, it is Halloween evening and a huge cold Alaskan-based storm has rolled through the Bay Area that has dumped our first rains of about a half an inch, provided a light-show of lightening with thunder, and, in some areas, snow in the lowlands. Last Monday (October 27), as we (Jeff Vierra, Eric Story, Mulan Chan, Alison Smith, myself and all the dogs—Anderson, Lakota, Sonica, and Henley) hiked up to the ridge above our vineyard on our four-mile-plus morning walk, I could feel that it would be a hot day. The temperature just kept climbing as we ascended. By mid-day it ended up being 100 degrees, totally unheard of for this time of the year. Soooo, in less than five days we have had a sixty-degree swing in temperature... Ahhhh, California!


Now, let's get down to some serious stuff: red wine. I have always felt that the most interesting, best buy red wine comes from the Rhône Valley. From this region you find general appellation productions that are complex yet provide pure enjoyment to consume near term. A perfect example of this is the **2000 Chapoutier Côtes du Rhône, "Belleruche"** (\$8.99). Filled with white pepper spiciness, blackberries and cherries on the nose and in its ever-evolving palate impression, this little gem

#### The Secret Clos

Many of the best vineyards in far northern growing regions are contained by walls known in French as "Clos." Perhaps the most famous of all of these is in Burgundy, the mighty Clos de Vougeot, Grand Cru, a vineyard that is so revered that French army regiments stop their progress to salute it. In the Rheingau in Germany the mighty Steinberger "Clos" has been producing some of that country's best wine for more than a thousand years. Champagne has a few famous Clos of its own, the most famous being Krug's Clos de Mesnil, which used to be the Clos Tarin and often went into Salon before it was sold in the 1970s. Bollinger's famous Ay Vielles Vignes Champagne comes from two tiny walled vineyards behind their winery, and Philiponnat owns the super steep south-facing Clos du Goisses (which I am hoping to offer this month) in Mareuil sur Ay. The least known of these fourwalled vineyards that are bottled separately in Champagne is responsible for the Cattier Clos du Moulin, 1er Cru, Brut Champagne (\$77.99). This Champagne is one of our most special, either as a true pleasure for a special occasion or as a great addition for your complete Champagne cellar. The Clos du Moulin is named after an old windmill that was damaged in World War I and destroyed completely in World War II. It has five-and-a-half acres planted half to Chardonnay and half to Pinot Noir. It is located in Chigny-les-Roses on the north side of the mountain of Reims. This release contains 1993, 1995 and 1996 harvests. The color is a pale gold, and it has an extraordinarily refined nose of white flowers and Macadamia nuts. On the palate it has hints of smoke from the high quality Pinot, as well as baked apricot and even pastry dough. But it is the finish that holds the real excitement with its Puligny-Montrachet-like lime character and gorgeous slate-y power. This is a great Champagne! ## Chinon, Rabelais and Me

Francois Rabelais (1494-1553) is one of France's greatest literary figures, famous the world over for his biting satire. Not too many of his fans know that Rabelais was also an ardent lover of Chinon. We have a lot in common, Rabelais and I; we both have an opinion (usually pretty fierce) on everything, and we both adore the wines of Chinon!

Now you'd think that with Francois as a spokesperson more folks would be hip to these very tasty and versatile wines. As this is not the case, however, I will rally to the cause! The wine growing region of Chinon is located in the cool district of Touraine in the Loire Valley. Made almost exclusively from cabernet franc, Chinon often displays a perfect combination of fruit and acidity, making it a perfect accompaniment to grilled steak, tuna, or even Asian meat dishes. The 2001 Château de la Bonneliere Chinon (\$11.99) is a glorious example, showing lively cherry, violets and just a touch of damp earth on the finish. Rabelais would also surely approve of the **2001 Lebreton** Domaine des Rochelles Anjou-Villages Brissac (\$13.99). This wine hails from the red wine appellation Anjou-Villages near the town of Angers, and is comprised of 90% cabernet sauvignon and 10% cabernet franc. It is vinified in stainless steel and sees no oak, and as a result is unique and absolutely delicious. Bright cherry, red currant, and dark chocolate are balanced by soft tannins and enough structure to hold up to a nice steak, hamburger or grilled quail. Have a great holiday, and in the immortal words of Rabelais, remember to "drink that delicious, precious, heavenly, joyful and divine liquor called wine."

As many of you know, we are big fans of the wines of **Domaine**Jean Tardy. Jean and his son Guillaume farm several vineyards for Meo-Camuzet. The amazing thing is how much less their wines sell for than Meo's! We found a small stash of 1999 Tardy wines, laid in at the old favorable exchange rate and are passing the prices on to you. The 1999 Vosne Romanée, "Les Vigneux" (\$29.99) has focused tannins, very good concentration and lots of depth. The 1999 Nuits-St-Georges, "Bas de Combes" (\$29.99) is elegant with lots of nerve and great length and toasty oak notes. Finally, the 1999 Nuits-St-Georges, "Les Boudots," 1er Cru (\$46.99) is one of the vineyards that produces fruit for Meo Camuzet. It lies on the border with Vosne Romanée, exhibits wonderful concentration from 50- to 70-year-old vines, phenomenal length, depth and elegance. The nose is open and rather Vosne Romanée-like, but on the palate it shows deep black fruit and lots of power.

In addition to these 1999s, more of the classically styled 2001s continue to arrive. The **2001 Domaine Dujac** wines have arrived as well as the **2001 Dujac Fils & Père** wines. Also just in for the holidays are the **2001 Comte de Vogüe** wines. Finally, the charming and lush **2001 Domaine Michel Gros** Burgundies have also arrived. Quantities on many of these offerings are tiny, so give me a call, send me an email or go online to check availability. A santé!

## Sotto la Pergola Inclinata

The Langhe hills of Piedmont, home to Barolo and Barbaresco, are amongst the most fascinating wine growing regions in the world. South of the Tanaro River near the town of Alba these finger-like projections offer some of the most dramatic vineyard exposures possible. Positioned in the center of the Barolo growing zone is the small commune of Monforte d'Alba home to the winemaking brothers Aldo and Riccardo Seghesio. The soft-spoken brothers produce some of the best Barolo in the area as well as award-winning Barbera and a scintillating Super Piemontese blend called "Bouquet."

A few years ago the brothers started using rotary fermenters to try and soften the tannins of Nebbiolo. This change, and a bit of aging in small French oak barriques has made their wines powerful yet supple, soft and full on the palate. The 1999 vintage for Barolo is another embarrassment of riches (1995 to 2001 produced seven straight vintages of superb quality wine). The 1999 vintage is like a cross between the lush, super ripe richness and body of the 1997 vintage and the elegant aromatics, supple texture and long finish of the 1998 vintage.

For the brothers Aldo and Riccardo, the **1999 Seghesio Barolo "La Villa" (\$42.99)** is powerful, chocked full of sweet rose petal aromatics, fruit, smoke and truffles, powerful enough to lay down for a decade plus but rich enough to drink now.

The **2001 Seghesio Barbera d'Alba "La Chiesa" (\$26.99)**, a previous multiple 3 Glass award winner from *Gambero Rosso* is stunning. Layers of complex ripe fruit wrapped around a supple core of concentration. Balanced, elegant but full in the mouth, a perfect choice for bringing a little sunshine into your life this winter especially with those wonderful winter dishes of braised meats or stews.

The **2000 Seghesio "Bouquet" Langhe Rosso (\$24.99)** is a blend of 50% merlot, 25% cabernet sauvignon and 25% nebbiolo. The complex aromatics of merlot waft gently from the glass as the power of the cabernet fills your mouth while the subtle yet omnipresent nebbiolo creates sparkling aromatic palate highlights. Lush and easy to drink, it would be the perfect match for risotto with porcini mushrooms, roasted pigeon or a classic pot roast!

**1999 Bussia Soprana Barbera d'Alba (\$9.99)**. Silvano Casiraghi is one of my favorite Barolo producers. I had visited this winery a few times before I even knew about his Barbera. Poor me!! This wine drinks so well right now—ripe cherries, coffee, spice and leather mingle with a touch of smoke on the finish. Perfect for holiday parties.

One of our Top Picks this month is The **2001 Felsina Chianti Classico (\$21.99)**. Felsina has always been one of those producers I can rely on, year in and year out, always a great wine. The 2001 is no exception. Full-bodied with fresh berries and hints of flowers, fresh herbs and a touch of chocolate. Very well crafted.

What to give as a gift to yourself or that special wine friend or (if you're lucky) that special boss? The **2000 "Porphyr" Cantina Terlan Lagrein Riserva (\$39.99)** WOW! Barnyard, chocolate, fruit, earth and spice are the exotic aromatics of this wine. On the palate you will find inky blackberries with some gaminess and well-integrated tannins. One or two hours of decanting is a must. YUM!

Another great gift idea is a **1997 Canalicchio (Franco Pacenti) Brunello di Montalcino Riserva (\$62.99)**, which received 93 points from Tanzer and 90 points from Parker. Lots of dark fruit here, black raspberries and cherries intermingled with tobacco and orange rind. Very well balanced with sweet tannins. Love the long and concentrated finish. A must have for the cellar.
