We are looking forward to our fiftieth year (Todd and I will be 80+ and getting ready to turn over some of the everyday responsibilities to our children). Seriously, it has been a wonderful experience for us—lots of ups and downs, but more ups than downs. Speaking of old geezers, recently I opened about twenty old California wines from my cellar for any of the staff who wanted to attend a Chantilly Restaurant (nextdoor to K&L RWC) dinner/tasting. Most of the wines were purchased from 1971 to 1979 and have rested undisturbed for up to 30 years. To make a long story short, 95% of the wines were still fresh and alive, including Louis Martini Dry Sauternes bottled in 1959, 1965 Heitz Pinot Chardonnay, 1967 Mirassou Cabernet, 1965 Krug Cabernet, 1966 Concannon Cabernet, etc,etc. What a revelation! A testament to excellent cellar conditions and the old time wineries making quite spectacular wines in the '50s, '60s, and early '70s. I can only hope Todd and I are in as good shape when we host our 50th anniversary party. —Clyde Beffa Jr

No, No, Nanook

I decided not to spend another snowless winter in San Francisco, so my friend HG Wells & I took off for pasts unknown. We arrived in 1936 Nepal, high in the Himalayas. Freezing our butts off, we stumbled into the local saloon, longside a guy named Rocky Raccoon. The barflies were shouting and whooping, their excitement focused on the main table, where the annual Celebrity Wine Shooter-Out was in full gulp. The finalists had selected premium Greek Estate and Japanese Junmai Ginjo Sake as the challenge, trying to out maneuver their opponents' tasting experience.

As soon as honorary Judge Judy dropped the starter's dirty red bandana, Indiana Jones immediately went elbow-to-elbow with his ex, Marion Ravenwood (no relation to the zinfandels). Indy poured red—a **1999 Merlot, Domaine Hatzimichalis** (\$25.99). Amazingly complex, it was unlike any merlot he had ever tasted: firm, long structure, delicious blackberry/ripe plum, soft herb, exquisite texture.

"In your face!" Marion countered, slamming her red—1999 Refosco, Domaine Mercouri (\$16.99). "You gotta be kidding! A wine this complex, loaded with deep, dry black cherry/blackberry/ plum, with layers upon layers of silky texture for under \$20? A challenge trump, fer sure!" Aphrodite, Goddess of Love, responded, "Sweets from the sweet, my dear!" downing a shot of the luscious Samos Muscat, Kourtaki (\$9.99), a pure, honeyed peach/apricot/fig beauty, full, rich and long. A steal.

"On to the sake," directed Judy. "Remember, the finest estate sake is drunk chilled, like fine white wine. And the Junmai Ginjo is from the top 2-3% produced." Hercules hoisted the shimmering Mantensai "Star Filled Sky" (\$27.99), crisp, dry and full-flavored, with a hint of honeysuckle and quince. It was Deep Purple's Ritchie Blackmore's turn and he wasted no time in whipping out his Strat, wailing "Moooon on the wah-ter," prior to swallowing the Fukucko "Moon on the Water" (\$31.99), wonderfully full, honeydew/ cantelope/mango tones with a long, dry finish that boggles the mind. The final honor fell to Japan's legendary Godzilla, who breathed no fire on the highly complex Mukune "Root of Innocence" (\$36.99), featuring dry wheat, green herb, lychee, fresh coconut—a melange of wonders.

"Winners all!" crowed Judge Judy. "Party on, dudes," flashed Grandmaster Cy O'Nara.

The Spotlight Shines Brightly on the Graves!

Happy New Year to everyone in the K&L universe. It's time to shed the hangovers and extra pounds of the holidays and get pumped up, focused, and back in shape! Do I sound convincing? I hope so because I have a lot of work to do after the decadence of last month.

Recently K&L owner and Bordeaux expert Clyde Beffa put our staff through a tasting, focusing on the Graves appellation of Bordeaux. It was badly needed; the Graves is a quiet, low profile region that has been overlooked for years by consumers who flock to the great estates of the Médoc and the charm of the small estates of St-Emilion and Pomerol. The combination of Mother Nature recently smiling brightly on the Graves weather and passionate winemaking by progressive Châteaux owners has helped bring the area to the forefront in Bordeaux. The appellation itself is due south of the city of Bordeaux; and the three most famous estates—Haut-Brion, La Mission Haut-Brion and Pape Clement—come from this area known as Pessac. Pessac was countryside when those estates were built, today it's the suburbs, surrounded by homes, cars, and traffic. The residual of this sprawl is warmth, which is why their grapes ripen 5-10 days earlier than anywhere else in Bordeaux. These estates will always be famous but the excitement in the Graves comes from the southern area called Leognan. This area, like France profonde, is vast and wild, full of large and small estates slowly carving out their reputation while surrounded by farms and forest.

The leader in this changing new world of the Graves is without question the Cathiard family. They purchased the large run-down estate of Smith-Haut-Lafite and renovated everything as well as built a fine hotel, spa, and two restaurants. This fabulous spot is called Les Source de Caudalie, a white-hot destination even for the French. From here it is minutes to other fine estates such as Haut-Bailly, Carbonnieux, Domaine de Chevalier, Haut-Bergey, and La Louvière. Les Source has spotlit the entire area and even the smaller estates have jumped in quality. The proof is always in the bottle, so try some of them listed below and remember that the 1998 vintage was outstanding in the Graves.

1998 Château Cantelys Blanc (\$16.95) Purchased by the Cathiards in 1996, this château has the same two consulting oenologists as at Smith-Haut-Lafite—the very famous and talented Michel Rolland (for red) and Denis Dubourdieu (for white). 50% semillon and 50% sauvignon blanc, this white wine is a lovely combination of richness and freshness. Barrel aged with a strong toasty character to complement the citrus and white peach aromas and flavors. Serve with grilled seafood or cheese.

1998 Château Cantelys Rouge (\$16.95) 70% cabernet sauvignon and 30% merlot. The Graves reds usually show a touch softer side of the cabernet, and tend to have an earthy vein that allows the wines to drink very well young. This 1998 features deep red fruit with hints of licorice and sweet black pepper. Bright and fresh.

1998 Beauregard Ducasse Rouge (\$10.99) This fabulous value comes from the highest spot in southern Graves, which means great drainage. 55% merlot and 45% cabernet, good solid richness and ripeness plus soft feel make this wine a stellar bottle of great everyday wine

1998 Château La Clotte (\$12.99) From the famous negociant firm of Sichel. This is the first time we have bought this wine, which features nice chunky fruit that will please even the toughest California palate. 50% cabernet and 48% merlot, a total of nine vineyard sites make up the blend. For \$12.99, it's quite amazing.

1998 Château Haut Vigneau (\$13.99) From the owner of Château Carbonnieux, Mr Anthony Perrin, this wine features good ripeness while being firm and elegant. It is spicy with a touch of minerals on the finish.

We move up the Médoc for our last two values: 1998 Château La Bessane (\$20.95) from Margaux has been one of the hottest wines in our selection and I order it in restaurants in France often. It offers velvety, richly-styled fruit that is as good as many classified wines. The 1998 is a bit bolder but give it a year or two to soften or an hour in the decanter. 1996 Domaine Gartieux (\$19.99) is the third wine of the great Pichon-Longueville-Comtesse de Lalande. This wine is only produced in the great vintages when the selection of the barrels is so good that even the lightest barrels make a lovely luncheon wine that can be served with white fish, salmon and chicken. Always tasty and balanced, it is almost all merlot in 1996.

Trey's picks for 2002!

Well, it's December in northern California and raining too hard to play golf, so I might as well write my article. I always like to start off with a chardonnay or two, so here are my picks for this month. The 1999 Miner Family "Oakville Ranch" Chardonnay (\$32.99) is a rich, buttery chardonnay with a full tropical middle, toasty, creamy texture, and a mouth-watering finish. This wine was a bit tight when we first received it, but has opened up beautifully. It will pair nicely with fish or even lighter pasta dishes. If you are a fan of those buttery chardonnays but some of them are too heavy on the finish, I would recommend that you try 1999 St Supery "Dollarhide Ranch" Napa Chardonnay (\$26.99). This limited edition bottling shows that rich, buttery texture upfront but finishes with melon and lemon flavors. The wine also shows flavors that include hazelnuts, cream, bananas, and vanilla. Excellent with every kind of fish or have it with appetizers.

On to the reds! As you may already know, merlot from Monterey can get a bit herbal and green, especially in cool years. When the growers get it right, this merlot can be outstanding. The 1999 Draper & Esquin Monterey Merlot (\$12.99) shows lots of sweet herbs, spicy bright fruit, and a soft smooth finish. Tons of fruit in this wine, it should pair well with just about anything. All this at a very reasonable price. Looking for cabernet sauvignon? Here are two hot deals. The 1997 Rubissow-Sargent Mt Veeder Cabernet Sauvignon (\$19.99) is a soft, lush red wine that is medium bodied and filled with flavors of raspberry, sweet herbs and spice. This is a wine that is ready to drink now and does not need to be cellared. It is perfect with pork, chicken and even beef. Don't let the old school label on 1997 Kunde Estate Reserve Sonoma Cabernet Sauvignon (\$34.99) fool you. It may look like it says 1897, but in fact it's a 1997, and it tastes like a 1997—deep, ripe, intense and full. It shows flavors of cassis, mint, toast, and silky tannins. This wine will age well over the next 10 years but who can wait that long.

Grown in a perfect, cool climate, it tastes like biting into one of those pears you get mail ordered! Super edge of light oak and spice. A totally awesome buy, dude (and dudette)!

1999 Cloverdale Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon (\$16.99) Another winner from the Pellegrini family. Extremely ripe fruit with a toasty oak edge and very pleasant finish. This will keep you happy through the Easter break at least!

LATER (meaning it would be splendid to give these bottles a few months)

2000 Mount Eden Santa Cruz Mountains K&L Cuvée Chardonnay (\$16.99) Small production (two separate 1-acre vineyards) and extreme care have netted this fantastic chardonnay. We had a chance to corner the market and Clyde bought it all. Rejoice (and take advantage of) our good fortune! Ccreamy and dreamy with a tight edge that will meld into something out of this world. Don't hesitate, at this price it won't last long at all.

1997 Amici Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon (\$42.99) As the great cab vintage of 1997 passes into history we dug around to find more. This wine is a true star. Very concentrated, it's dynamite! A bit of tannin and acid will hold it together very well, though it's the perfect accompaniment to a nice thick ribeye steak right now! Decant for sure or better yet give it till September yeah, that's the ticket, September. Happy New Year, *BK*

After the roller coaster ride that was the year 2001, I'm looking forward to 2002. Ups and downs marked the last year, and some of our finest and saddest moments were had. All in all, we at K&L emerged grateful for what we have, and committed to doing our best for you again this year. In the little ways we make our customers' lives a little better, we take great pleasure and pride. Our hard working California buyer has been doing his part, and has come up with a store full of great wines to celebrate the new year. I'll be celebrating this month, and have compiled a list of some of the wines gracing my table. A terrific wine to try is the 1997 Cronin Cabernet (\$21.99), rich and structured, with complexity, earth and a great balance, this wine really shows how great California's Santa Cruz Mountains vineyards can be. Another real treat is the 2000 Frei Brothers Merlot (\$16.99), sweet and juicy fruit mark this wine's style, with plump blue fruit dominating and notes of cocoa underneath—a great buy. The 2000 Honig Sauvignon Blanc (\$11.99) may be my favorite SB at the moment and for good reason. With a bold core of ripe fruit and a crisp and stylish finish, this wine will hold up to a wide range of midweight dishes. If you haven't tried this wine, you owe it to yourself to give it a go. When you're in the mood for pinot noir, you have to try the 1999 Kalinda Pinot Noir (\$11.99). From Carneros, this is one of the few pinots that costs just a little, and delivers way beyond expectations. Smooth, medium-weight cherry fruit, with gorgeous flower petals and a touch of French style meatiness are followed by a sweet silky finish. You just can't go wrong with this wine. For flash, the 1999 Katherine Kennedy "Lateral" (\$24.99) is another big winner. Big, plump, juicy, ripe cassis and chocolate fill the palate and a long sweet plum finish lingers. This is a right-bank blend from a fantastic producer that is usually very hard to find. Try one, you'll love it! Wishing you a healthy and happy 2002.—Shaun Green

The Moschofilero grape, unique to Greece, has a black/gray skin but produces a white wine (blanc de gris) It has a wonderful tart/fruit counterpoint, with excellent texture, length, and complexity.

Produced on the gorgeous island of Santorini, this is a fabulous dessert wine. After harvest, the grapes are dried for about a week before making the wine. Rich, ripe, racy, with flavors of honey, caramel, peach, hazelnut, soft herb. It has very good acidity, great balance, viscosity, and length.

Happy New Year—Port, Shoes and Drunken Stemware

During the last decade at this wine shop there have been myriad changes, a supersonic evolution in comparison to the first 15 years of our humble existence, when the shop was run much like a fast food restaurant: stripped down selection, an accent on low prices, and a crew composed of a couple of adults surrounded by an army of kids. As the crew grew up they developed a passion for the product and a roll-up-the sleeves-and-go-to-work attitude. This era lasted 15 years as we unknowingly evolved from a discount bomber to a fine wine house. Budweiser stacked to the ceiling disappeared, Carlo Rossi and Sebastiani jug wines marched toward extinction. We tasted more wine, formed opinions, discussed our discoveries. We changed locations, added staff, and altered our focus. We were growing up as a company.

The last decade was marked by stunning growth and a loss of balance in the staff. Hiring changed; with a new doctrine stressing professionalism first. The wine experience would come later. It didn't work—without the passion, we began to ever so slightly resemble a dot com company. Happily, those new hires moved on and balance was restored into a blend of long time wine veterans and bright, energetic young people who shared the commitment to being a successful wine merchant, everyone putting the best bottle for the occasion into the hands of what became loyal customers. We built clientele, maintained stock, worked the phones, the floor, whatever it took. I spent these same years splitting time selling Bordeaux, cleaning toilets, and doing deliveries, but I'd not change the experience for anything. It's odd to be considered one of the "old dogs" here, but I am part of the balance—a person for every task, a blend of talents, diversity with a common goal. You are in better hands than ever if you buy from this merchant.

Jeff Vierra has a lifetime warranty on this pair of very interesting shoes, and he's going to make the company wish that they had never offered it. The quality of the workmanship is dubious, and when a hole appears in the toe (this happens with alarming regularity), ZIP!—back to the shop he goes, coming out with a brand new pair. I think he's gone through a dozen pairs. I don't ring up his purchases at K&L, he'd make me recycle the bottles when he's done.

I'm in this port warp. It seems to cross my path more than any other wine, so let's keep the streak alive: 1985 Croft. Croft is the first vintage port that I ever purchased, the 1963 vintage. Mentor Norm Jacobs had to convince me that it was worth the \$13 price tag. It was so extravagant that I only bought one. This 1985 will not take as long to be ready—all systems are go right now. 1977 Grahams. A powerhouse port. Intensity of ripeness and the quite sturdy construction—a great wine, a great vintage. Still on the tannic side and into the third and final stage of evolution, this is one of those port wines that can be drunk now or twenty years from now, and is in very short supply. 1989 Rieussec. This famous sauternes château has a long track record of fine quality that continues without missing a beat, even as twice in the last 3 decades the ownership has changed. The wines are intense sweet and fruited, the '89 brimming with ripe pear and pineapple balanced by aging in new oak barrels. Expect the wine to improve for another decade with ease

A quick story: Hall of Fame customer Ray Epes has a very discerning wife. Kathy Epes bought some Riedel glassware, but returned one of the glasses because it did not meet her standards. Ray brought it in in a paper bag marked "Return to K&L. This glass wobbles." I've only known that to happen after midnight.

Jim's January Two Thousand and What? Gems

Rex is lying on his back and ogling me with his warm green eyes in total contentment trying to inspire me to write this column.

Our direct import program has delivered some monumentally exciting wines at reasonable prices for everyday consumption. I find it difficult to understand why anyone would spend their hard-earned cash on wines that are highly over-priced "cult" or "trophy" wines because some advertisement said so. Have we forgotten what wine is about? It is to be consumed and enjoyed! Expand your horizons and venture into wines that are not only satisfying but affordable. Check out the list of wines below. Not only are they wines worth buying, but wines that should be consumed.

The 1999 Château de Montfaucon Côtes du Rhône (\$7.99) is mediumdeep ruby in color, possesses a lovely set of aromatics of plums, cassis, spice, and cinnamon. It is medium-full in body, soft in tannins especially noticeable on the finish, balanced, and easy drinking. This is not meant to be put down for any length of time. Super value at this price and Rex says that is deserves seven tail wags.

1998 Romain Bouchard, Côtes du Rhône Villages, "Valreas" (\$9.99) is another winner from a truly exceptional vintage. Typical of the 1998 vintage, this wine is deep ruby, inky in color in appearance. Incredible

nose of plums, apricots, cedar, earthy, Portobello mushroom meatiness. The flavors are big, chunky, full, concentrated, viscous, round, and long. As with the Montfaucon, the tannins are soft and round, which makes this pretty wine a close runner-up to my house red for January. Rex says seven tail wags.

One of my favorite wines being produced are those from Corbieres. We have tasted and sold some fairly incredible Rhône-type wines from this commune over the years (most notably from Octavia of Cuvée Sextant fame) that are comprised of mourvedre, syrah, and grenache (and occasionally merlot). 1999 Domaine du Trillol, Corbieres "Eleve en Fut de Chêne" (\$7.99) is lush, concentrated, opaque in appearance and color. Fleshy, white pepper, plumy, earthy, antique-like on the nose, which leads to a deep and a fulfilling set of flavors of cassis, currants, soft tannins, excellent depth and a long, warm finish. Rex was blown away by its quality.

Champagne and Sherry for 2002

My favorite thing about January has eight legs, two claws, and goes great with blanc de blancs champagne: crab. My favorite way to serve it is on top of a rich, chicken-stock-based risotto, flavored with lemon zest. If you load a layer of crabmeat into a warm ramekin, fill the rest of it with risotto and invert it on a warm plate you will have an instant, dramatic presentation. The only thing missing is the wine. The '96 Pierre Peters (\$48.99) is a natural with a dish like this. Made out of chardonnay from the estate's vineyards in the Grand Cru of Mesnil, this wine has the purity to complement the lemon flavor and the acidity to match the richness of the crab. Another great match would be the 1996 Ayala Blanc de Blancs (\$35.99), a broad shouldered, all chardonnay wine, but with the fantastic zip of the vintage as a balance. Not only will it go extremely well with your crustacean, it is excellently priced. If you are not in the mood for fussing, these wines are great with cracked crab, a couple of lemons, and flaky sourdough bread as well. For dessert I recommend a chunk of Cotswald cheese and a big glass of San Rafael Oloroso Dulce (\$22.99). This is my 40-year-old sherry of choice for cold January nights. The salty notes in the wine will match the sharpness of the cheese, while the wine's sweetness will provide a foil for it. Much too decadent for such a low price! 2000 Glen Carlou Chardonnay Paarl-Simonsberg (\$12.95) This South African wine is a super value. The young winemaker David Finlyson thinks of the property as primarily a chardonnay producer, as does partner Donald Hess (Hess Collection) who recently bought an 18 ha. parcel next door to be planted with chardonnay. More burgundian in style, the wine offers a bouquet of nuts, spice, light toasted oak and ripe pear to apple fruit. These elements follow on the palate with fine balancing acidity and a long finish.

2001 Delheim "Dry Red" (\$9.95) Delheim has been a major part of the history of modern Cape wine. Since 1988, winemaker Philip Costandius has continued to be an innovator and raise the bar for their wines. Here is a lovely daily red that is easy to drink and won't break the bank. Made from 42% pinotage and the balance cabernet and merlot, the wine shows ripe plums with a hint of earth and herb accented by a mocha note. The wine is quite supple on the palate with good length. A great deal and a candidate for case purchases!

1998 Pikes Cabernet Sauvignon Clare Valley (\$19.95) Here we have a cabernet of elegance. Made from 95% cabernet and 5% cabernet franc, the wine is aged for 18 months in French barriques. The nose is full of cassis, smoky black cherry, violets, and a hint of sage. The wine shows fine balance with good acidity and a super finish. 87pts Tanzer.

2000 Clonakilla "Hilltops" Shiraz Canberra (\$18.95) Dr John Kirk is a pioneer of the Canberra region in New South Wales, making his first vintage there in 1976 and spending considerable time researching local climates. The "Hilltops" offers a bouquet that bursts with ripe blackberry, roasted grains and some northern Rhône meaty notes. These follow on the palate with good acidity, chalky tannins, a hint of earth and very fine length.

Last month I told you about a new product for us from New Zealand, the Huia Pinot Noir. Well, we couldn't stay away and have two new offerings from their portfolio. First up is the 1997 Huia Marlborough Brut. This is a fabulous bubbly made from 53% pinot noir and 47% chardonnay that shows accents of fresh bread, yeast and soft cherry fruit. The wine has a very fine bead and outstanding length. Even Gary Westby liked it with its nod in style to Veuve Cliquot, even though winemaker Clare Allen spent time at Taittinger. Next is the 2001 Huia Pinot Gris, and I love this wine! With a beautiful nose of lime, cantaloupe and a light white flower floral note, the wine is rich and round with fine acidity and a terrific finish. Here's to a great 2002, *Jim C*.

Pour Votre Plaisir

There are still some delightful 1999 Red Burgundies arriving, but not too many more to come. One of the areas which had great success in 1999 was the Coate Chalonaise, just south of the Côte de Beaune. Although the quality of many of the wines from this area has come up sharply in quality, they're not yet as well known (which means they are great values). A new Domaine to our shores is Domaine Saint-Jacques, by Christophe-Jean Grandmougin. The cellars date to the 14th century, but it has only been in the Grandmougin family since 1955. Christophe-Jean took over at age 22, after studying oenology and interning in Côte Rôtie and Burgundy for 6 years. His 1999 Rully Rouge, 1er Cru, "La Fosse" (\$21.99) has clean, focused fruit, with very pretty cherry notes, and elegant fine tannins. Aged in 50 % new oak, it is quite lovely, and opens to show much more depth after an hour or two. The 1999 Rully Blanc, 1er Cru, "Marissou," shows toasty notes and a very elegant style. The vines are 45-90 years old and it shows in the concentration, finesse, elegance and length of this wine. Jean Marc Boillot makes some of the more lovely Volnays around. His 1999 Bourgogne Rouge (\$14.99) has lovely fruit and is a great value for the price. The 1999 Volnay (\$31.99) is a blend from 5 different parcels, with very old vines. It is soft, supple and forward, but has more tannins than you think, masked by the fact that they are very fine, as well as by the fruit in the wine. Great intensity and focus, lovely aromatics.

Henri Gouges is once again acknowledged as one of the very top producers in Nuits-St-Georges, following a difficult period in the 1970s. Their 1999 Nuits St-Georges (\$31.99) is a full-bodied and quite delicious Pinot, with balance and good length. Winemaker Christian Gouges describes 1999 as "a very pinot year. The wines . . . [have] been good since the start and will probably always taste good. Nature can give this combination of production and high quality only once every 30 years." Bruno Clair is known as the master of Marsannay. His 1999 Marsannay, Longeroies (\$24.99) is very rich and full. It has the firm tannins you expect of Marsannay, but what presents itself most obviously is the intense, lovely and elegant fruit. This is really a bargain! Montalcino, the tiny southern Tuscan hill town that is famous for Brunello, is in a rapidly changing area; recent fame belies the recent past. Fifty years ago just after WWII, woodcutting, sheep, and honey producing dominated the economy with little more than a dozen producers of wine. Today the Consorzio has more than 130 members and vineyard prices in Montalcino are amongst the highest in Europe. The last decade has produced incredible quality increases for Montalcino; this sleepy hill town on the edge of humanity produces wine that is growing in quality by leaps and bounds. The Solaria Estate is one of the new wineries bursting with ideas and increased quality. Winemaker/owner Patrizia Cencioni bears all the knowledge of previous generations but glows with the determination of youthful endeavor. Besides the usual Brunello and Rosso for the region she has created her own "Super Tuscan" called Solarianne. The 1998 Solaria "Solarianne" (\$59.99) is dramatic, dynamic, lush, ripe, and chocolatey, a seductive wine that rolls across the palate with layers of spice, dense fruit, with a core of concentration to ensure longevity but luxurious enough to drink now. Solarianne is a unique combination of the power, density, and ripeness of the 70% cabernet sauvignon coupled with 30% sangiovese that adds length, brightness, and a taste of cherries and plums that lingers in a long-lasting finish. This is a special purchase and only available here at K&L for a limited time.

The Alto Adige continues to be one of the least known wine produc-

ing areas in Italy. This onetime Austrian province called Sud Tirol is nestled in a dramatic Alpine river valley with vertical walls that rival Yosemite. The Lagrein grape is an offshoot of Syrah, what the original cross was or further hybridization created is as of yet unknown until further DNA study is completed. To say that Lagrein tastes like Syrah would definitely not be true, however, there are some close parallels. This producer is the oldest cooperative in the Alto Adige and has created a tremendously exciting wine: the 1999 Cantina Produttori Andriano Lagrein "Tor di Lupo" (\$24.99). Dynamic, with a core tasting of concentrated blueberries and blackberries it's a big wine, with a spicy twist of black pepper and mineral balanced with a discreet touch of French oak in the finish. Power, size, depth and capable of aging another decade, this is a great bottle of wine, consistently a 2 bicchieri winner in the Gambero Rosso.

The 1998 Badia di Morrona Vignaalta (\$29.99) is stunning. This old vine Sangiovese has incredible purity, chocolate cherries, spice, leather, truffles flow from the glass. A difficult vintage in Chianti, it was very good at the Badia, and more drinkable now than the 1997 with superb fruit and balance. 1998 Badia di Morrona "N'Antia" (\$24.99) is the fantasy Super Tuscan blend of 40% cabernet, 20% merlot and 40% sangiovese. It's lush, full-bodied, and full of complex fruit character to drink now or to age. Saluti! —*Greg St Clair*

Jeff's Picks: Grans-Fassian

Gerhard Grans is making truly compelling Rieslings in his bend of the Mosel river at Leiwen. His top sites include the Trittenheimer Apotheke, and Piesporter Goldtr pfchen, all of which are on Devon Slate which provides for good drainage and gives the wine its mineralic and racy character. The growers of Leiwen have consitantly shown the potential for quality in their village and Grans-Fassian has lead that charge. Gerhard's wines show fine polish and robust acidity coupled with elegence and sensational richness, due in part to the careful selection of grapes, extended lees contact and individual maturation in stainless steel and large oak barrels. The 2000 Grans-Fassian Estate Riesling (\$11.99) is from a blend of sites and is light and fresh with crisp acidity and juicy citrus laden fruit. A wine for all occasions and a great introduction to his style. The wines of the Apotheke are sleek and minerally, possessing a classic elegance that defines the Mosel style. Add to that Mr. Grans and you get the 1999 Trittenheimer Apotheke Auslese (\$32.99), a lovely bouquet of peaches and apricots, rich and leesy with mouth smacking acidity that lasts and lasts. Finally there are small quantities of 1999 Trittenheimer Apotheke Auslese Gold Cap (375ml, \$26.99), which is a botrytis selection that overpowers with its fullness of tropical fruits and spice, lavish texture and Your "back page man," Jeff Vierra impressive structure.
