1996 Ruelle-Pertois Grand Cru\$29.99

This is elegant, restrained champagne. The fruit is all grand cru from vineyards in Chouilly and all Chardonnay. The wine has a pale straw color and a slow, pin point carb. On the nose it has wonderful minerals and just a hint of macadamia like nuttiness. It is very dry and has a crisp, refreshing finish that begs for another sip.

Lallement Reserve\$45.99

Although not labeled as such it is all from the 1996 vintage. Made of 80% pinot noir and 20% chardonnay this champagne might be too much wine for some people, but if you are a fan of Krug and Bollinger, you must try it!

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2001 Bordeaux: The Rodney Dangerfield Vintage.

Absolutely no respect for this fine vintage. Well, how do you think the 1983 vintage felt after 1982? And have you tasted a 1983 Bordeaux lately? Passing their teen years in fine form, many of these underappreciated and undervalued wines are delicious right now. Some are even better now than their 1982 counterparts—Palmer, La Conseillante, Margaux, Domaine de Chevalier, for example. All in all the 2001 Bordeaux vintage is not as even as the 2000. 2000 Bordeaux wines were good from the bottom to the top of the spectrum—from a simple bordeaux such as Roustaing to the already legendary Cheval Blanc. The buying frenzy and sky-high prices for 2000 Bordeaux is finally slowing down. Most of the property owners lowered their 2001 prices from 15-40% and now we have a fine vintage at affordable prices. I did not buy any 2000 Bordeaux for my cellar, but I will buy the best of the 2001s. The first growths are 50-75% less expensive than the 2000s. And they are not that far behind in quality. In ten years, most people will be hard pressed to tell them apart. Some of the super seconds such as Pichon-Lalande and Cos d'Estournel made better wines in 2001 than in 2000. And the prices for these '01s are \$30-\$60 less per bottle! Barton and Lynch-Bages at under \$35 are much better values than their 1997, 1998, and 1999 offerings.

I have no qualms saying that in regard to quality 2001 Bordeaux are far better than their 1983 counterparts—especially the first growths. Eighteen years of advanced vineyard and enology practices have made the wines of Bordeaux better than ever. Some super values for your consideration are Smith-Haut-Lafitte (\$31.99), La Lagune (\$23.99), Grand-Puy Lacoste (\$25.99), Pontet-Canet (\$26.99), and Gigault "Cuvée Viva," (\$13.49). I also believe that you will get more wine for your money from 2001 Bordeaux than from the 2000 vintage. Just like Rodney Dangerfield, 2001 Bordeaux deserves some respect. —*Clyde Beffa, Jr*

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Jim C's View Down Under

1999 Wood Park Cabernet-Shiraz (\$10.99) From the King Valley in northeast Victoria, we have a super deal with this brawny cab-shiraz blend. The wine is packed with concentrated blackberry fruits with hints of cigar box and licorice. While full bodied, the wine has good balance with elegance and integrated use of oak. We sold the 1998 vintage for \$22.95. Don't miss this great value.

1999 Majella Cabernet Sauvignon Coonawarra (\$24.99) This is a very impressive wine. From the cooler area of Coonawarra, this wine shows great breed and elegance. Made from 100% cabernet, there is a beautiful nose of violets, ripe cassis and blackberry. These flavors marry on the palate with a hint of mint in the long finish. Mr Parker rated the '98 at 91pts and called the producer the finest in Coonawarra. Currently, this wine just got 91pts from the *Wine Spectator*, and it's a must have!

2000 Frankland Estate "Isolation Ridge" Chardonnay (\$18.99) Frankland Estate produces lovely wines from Western Australia that manage to walk that delicate line between power and elegance. The bouquet offers notes of smoke and minerals with hints of pineapple and apricot, laced with butterscotch. A long and cool fermentation in barrel with a daily stirring of the lees for the first month gives the wine fine texture. 25% of the juice, all from low-yielding Mendoza clones, went thru malolactic fermentation leaving the wine with good acid balance and marvelous length.

2000 Mountford Pinot Noir Waipara Valley NZ (Inquire) CP Lim has fashioned another fine pinot from a somewhat difficult vintage. Coming back from working a harvest in Oregon, he feels the wine reflects a bit of that style. While lighter in color and weight compared to the 1999, there is much to like with this more elegant offering. The bouquet is full of ripe strawberry-raspberry fruit with accents of clove and some toffee notes. These flavors follow on the palate with fine balance and a persistent finish. Perfect with grilled salmon smoked with alderwood.

2001 Lynskeys Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough NZ (\$13.99) A new arrival, this Lynskeys is packed vibrant gooseberry and pink grapefruit flavors with aromatics of red pepper and citrus blossom. There is excellent balancing acidity and fine length. Try with clams, oysters, or the classic . . . shrimp on the "barbie". —*Jim Chanteloup*

2001 Red Bordeaux: The Price Is Right!

When we came to print last month we did not know the key factor in how successful the 2001 red Bordeaux vintage would be for everyone involved, especially you and me—the consumers. The price, it's *always* about the price. Is it a good deal? bad deal? lukewarm or not interesting? Speaking to our customers all across the country for 8 hours a day one thing is clear. The record high pricing of 2000 Bordeaux and California Cabernet Sauvignon has people back peddling away.

That is why for the 2001 vintage it's imperative that the wines are priced correctly. Guess what, the Bordelais got it right! As a buyer/collector myself, I am thrilled with the pricing of the 2001Bordeaux vintage and the fine wine and value it offers. Some 90% of the estates came down one third or more in price. The proof is in the finest estates' pricings; I'm buying. Bravo and chapeau!

The great first growths of Latour, Margaux, Haut-Brion along with Lafite and Mouton-Rothschild are all \$119.95, and each is very fine with a long life ahead. I tasted 1979 Lafite-Rothschild last eve with my family and it was sensational. In my mind 1979 and 2001 have some comparisons but 2001 is much better and the 22 years in between have been monumental in the advancement of viticulture and oenology.

Here are some more of the fine wines from 2001 that are on my personal hit parade and will make it into my ever expanding cellar. Let's start with the best way to learn and drink the first growths themselves: you drink the second wines and learn the style and flavor profiles first. Les Forts de Latour (\$32.99) is bright purple, very deep, sweet cherry, toast, spice and leather, yum! Pavillion Rouge, Château Margaux (\$25.99) has lovely softness, ripe fruity, and is great, as usual. I had the 1986 recently and it was superb. Carruades de Lafite (\$25.99) is full of roses, cherries, and is tightly balanced.

The cellar door will slam behind the usual suspects such as **Léoville-Barton** (\$33.95), **Lynch Bages** (\$34.95), **Gruaud Larose** (\$30.99) "third great one in a row!" **Cos d'Estournel** and **Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande** are both \$49.95. But there are many other great wines just as important that are the great buys of the 2001 vintage: **Château Branaire Ducru** (\$21.99), is a velvety beauty of red fruit and **Château Beychevelle** (\$22.99) is bright, tasty, and super clean, with blueberry and minerals. And how can I forget my love, **La Lagune** (\$23.99), always so elegant; These last three wines will be fantastic early and will hold. Can I pass up **Calon Segur at \$25.95**? Are you kidding me! It's almost as good as the 2000, as is **Leoville-Poyferre** (\$27.99), a lovely with cassis/raspberry fruit and classy balance. **Pontet Canet** (\$26.99) has crafted another very serious wine loaded with deep, spicy purple fruit and all kinds of blackberry/blueberry and plum flavors in a big rich, complex package!

The commune of Margaux is tingling with exciting wines from estates that have been dormant for decades and are now receiving the love of huge financial investments from ownerships passionately driven to make great quality wine. **Château Giscours (\$22.99)**, and **Château du Tertre (\$20.99)** show you the new world style of big richness and flesh and are superb. **Château Brane Cantenac (\$34.99)** and **Château d'Issan (\$21.99)** are a bit more restrained in a classic style. All four feature the hallmark smoothness, polish and beauty that is the appellation of Margaux.

As you can see I'm very excited about many of these and there are more! But I'm running out of room in this column, on my credit cards and in my wine locker! Guess I better not quit my day job

Great Buys in a "Buyers Market"

In my four years buying California wines, I have never really seen a "buyers market"—until now. About a year ago prices were at an all time high. It wasn't uncommon for a wine from 1997 to be double the price of their 1994 release. In spite of that, top California wines kept selling off the shelves faster than we could put them up. Today it's a bit different. In the current market, wine shoppers seem to be much more selective at what they purchase along with being much more price sensitive. The good news for our customers is that many wineries have lowered their prices due to a decrease in demand. There are some great buys out there if one looks. The Artesa Napa Cabernet Sauvignon is a wine which we sold a ton of 1997 at \$29.99. We now are selling the **1998 for \$16.99**. Is the 1997 \$13-a-bottle better than the 1998? No chance! The 1998 is lovely wine with plenty of fruit, balance and complexity to stand up against many other vintages like 1996 or 1995. Artesa also makes an outstanding Chardonnay from Carneros, which now sells for \$14.99. I have seen this wine closer to \$20 a bottle. It is full and rich upfront with hints of pears, melon, fresh green apples and toast. Another example of a great buy today is the 1998 St Supery Napa Cabernet Sauvignon (\$19.99). We blasted the 1997 out at \$26.99. The 1998 shows soft red cherry fruit, spice, minerals and actually drinks better right now than the 1997.

For zinfandel fans I have two picks this month. The first is the 1999 Joseph Swan "Frati Vineyard" (\$28.99). After tasting the wine I bought everything our wholesaler had and unfortunately it was not much. It could easily be the best zinfandel in California right now. My other Zinfandel pick is the 2000 Rusina Sonoma Zinfandel (\$24.99). This is more of a classic style zinfandel with elegant flavors of spice and ripe red berry fruits which are balanced and harmonious. Our staff went nuts for this wine at a recent staff tasting! — Trey Beffa

Brian's Best Bets

Three wines I will drink with you (if invited) . . .

After a month off I am chomping at the bit to write up three more wines . . . something to drink now.

1999 Zellerbach California Chardonnay (\$5.99) Look at the price of this wine! You can't afford not to try it. For a mere \$6 you run off with a terrific everyday drinker. Very well made, this wine has fresh fruit—apples and pears—with lots of tropical flavors, a hint of oak and a great balanced finish. It's not mushy. Quality that is awfully tough (if not down right impossible) to beat at this price.

1999 Kalinda Alexander Valley Zinfandel (\$10.99) Jim Barr gave it 10 tails a-waggin' and that alone made me take another look. We really have a terrific red here for you to enjoy all the live-long day. You will love the spicy fruit, good rich middle of raspberries and its light oak edge. Another wine that has no mushy aftertaste—and is full of ripe fruit flavors. Down with mush, up with fruit.

2000 Kalinda Dry Creek Cabernet Sauvignon (\$14.95) There's that label again—Kalinda. A moment please to remember all the great juice this label has brought us. What we have here is a beautiful cab just coming into it's own. Lots of ripe, cassis flavors with a very pretty edge of just enough toasty oak, the finish is long and clean. It tastes great now and it will be interesting to see how this wine matures over the next 6 months or so. Another big winner for your pocketbook!

Taste Explosions for July

Having just returned from a patriotic visit to our nation's capitol, I have some red and white (and blue?) all American gems for your Independence month table. Stray south from the Napa/Sonoma wine region stronghold, and you will find some great wines of character and power just down the coast, they were once just trying to make a go of it down the central coast, but times have changed, and the wines have proven the unique qualities and great winemaking potential of this area. Hit Santa Cruz and taste the toasty and mouth-filling 2000 Storr's Santa Cruz Mountains Chardonnay (\$18.99). This wine has a big, toasty, roasted hazelnut aroma filling the head with richness, and a medium full palate of baked pear fruit, with more toasty oak and nuttiness to go along, quite a booming wine for a great price. Further down the coast to Chalone AVA in Monterey county, the 2000 Testarossa 'Michaud' Chardonnay (\$34.99) is a serious powerhouse of a wine, full of roasted almonds, and tropical fruits, toasty and rich with great structure and firmness, ageable and still smooth on the palate, and showing a lot of class for a wine this big! Still further down the coast, from Santa Barbara comes the 2000 Testarossa Bien Nacido Vineyard Chardonnay (\$29.99) is another seriously large wine. Rich with oakiness, and tropical fruits, pineapple and mango, great acidity a fat mouth-fulling richness laced with hazelnuts and smoky toasted oak, deep gorgeous color and a nice long California finish, lushness, power and structure, what more could we ask! Backtrack a bit back up the coast into Paso Robles for a red wine, and experience the jammy plumpness of the 1999 Adelaida Meritage (\$21.99) big and ripe with a mound of blackberry jam fruit down the middle, laced with just a hint of herbs, and smoothed with vanillan oak and a very cool mineral spice just wafting through. Mostly cabernet franc and merlot with a quarter cabernet sauvignon, this juice bomb has all the moves and explosive fruit to be perfect for that 4th of July blowout. —Shaun

Ay Caramba!

Here are a few gems that I tasted while doing a whirlwind tour of Spain. More goodies that I tried on this trip are coming in the next couple of weeks. Check the Spanish section on the website for updates!

2001 Palacio de Menade Rueda White (\$7.49) Made from a blend of 90% verdejo, 8% viura, and 2% sauvignon blanc, the Palacio is made without malolactic fermentation and sees no oak. From the aromas of lime peel and anise to the bright, clean flavors on the palate, this white is sure to please. The long, crisp finish and mineral qualities remind me of a lively white wine from the Loire Valley. Enjoy the Palacio de Menade as an aperitif or, like we had it at the winery, with whole fresh shrimp and lemon.

2001 Pazo de Senorans Albarino (\$14.99) Don't wait for Parker to give this wine another 90 point score! This 2001 is their best effort to date—bright and lively with aromas of white peach, key lime, and minerals. From the richness on the palate to the long crisp finish, this Spanish white wine will please in the pickiest of wine palates. I love this wine with a lobster and watercress salad, a classic dish from Galicia!

2000 Capcanes Mas Donis (\$7.49) The latest vintage of our most popular Spanish red is here! From a blend of 80% garnacha from 60+year-old vines and 20% syrah, this wine from Tarrgona will knock you out with its big fruit and spice. The last 3 vintages have all been on Mr Parker's "best buy" list, so I wouldn't hesitate with this one. Remember how fast the last vintage sold out!

2000 Castano Hecula (Inquire) 2000 Castano Solanara (Inquire) Thanks to Mr Parker's 92and 90-point scores, we have gotten more calls about the Castano wines than almost any other Spanish wine in the market. The Hecula is a 100% monastrell (mouvedre) from old vines that is aged for 7 months in wood. It is thick and rich with plenty of rip blackberry fruit and black pepper spice. The Solanara is a blend of 70% monastrell, 20% tempranillo and 5% tinto rera and aged for 6 months in new American oak. This thick, rich red has some smoky and earthy aromas which are followed on the palate with ripe black fruits, a touch of vanilla oak and a long spicy finish. If you love big reds, you must try these 2 wines. Buen Provecho—Anne Pickett

Scene. A crowded courtroom in the rural South, set in black and white. There is a lot of handkerchief and fan action, a tribute to the abnormally hot movie set. A tall, skinny white lawyer named Atticus Nauseum approaches the stand, bespectacled and beside himself. He speaks: "Your honor, we wish to have these charges dropped. My client, Jim "Boo" Barr, could not possibly have stolen any Pichon-Lalande, as much as he may covet it. You see, he has hands for feet and feet for hands and must walk on his head, thereby compressing his brain. Despite the fact that he will later become a famous actor, he has not the wherewithal to pull a heist of this magnitude."

Judge: I just can't believe that this article is about Pichon-Lalande again. The last seven out of six columns have featured this venerable Château. Can't this be about something else? (Shuffling, snuffling sounds, a cough here, a murmur there. Basic '50s courtroom stuff. The judge continues.) Let's get some of the wine stuff out of the way early, shall we? I see that you've got the 1981. Elegant. Refined. Classic. I own a case (less the one I tasted, of course), but I missed out on the '85 and the '86. I should be held in contempt for that!

Atticus: No need to worry, your honor. It will be available as soon as I can come up with a lame premise upon which to recover it. Then you may sample the '85, finally ready, heady and ripe with vanilla and sweet cherry fruit, quite typically juicy for the vintage, and the '86, a long distance runner with the potential to be one of the greatest ever from Lalande. This wine is destined to go up in value the closer it gets to maturity, so now is the time to buy.

Jim's July Gems

Harvest update: This has been an interesting spring. It began with a mild warm days the first two weeks, but for the next several months temperatures were unseasonably below normal. Still, the crop set was huge and is evolving nicely. This pending harvest promises to be the largest on record, which is exactly what most of the wineries don't want now. Most are looking at backlogs inventories at both their facilities and their distributor's warehouses—the result of high, artificially created prices—and realizing that there needs to be cutbacks. Two weeks ago, Gallo dropped their contracts with all their independent growers in the North Coast. Since Gallo sets the standard for the per ton price for grapes, most contracts with other major wineries with independent growers were cancelled, too. So, you are probably asking, "What does all of this mean?" No grower wants to enter the beginning of the summer without a contract; that suggests financial disaster. Two weeks ago the average asking price for chardonnay, for example, dropped from \$2000 per ton for North Coast fruit to \$800 per ton. The next several months should be interesting. From a grower and winery standpoint, this is a very volatile and unhealthy situation. From a consumer standpoint, we should begin seeing some excellent sales on some exceptional product. While in Champagne on a buying trip about a year ago, Jeff and Gary stumbled (quite literally) on a boutique champagne producer in the small commune of Brouillet. The estate sparkling wine productions from **Ariston Fils** are wonderfully delicious and a real bargain. This house's "Carte Blanche" Brut (\$19.99) makes many other productions that retail for \$10 or more taste like water. Yeasty, nutty, yet clean and showing a subtle richness, this has turned into my favorite multivintage Brut. One other unique aspect about the Ariston productions is that their champagnes are only disgorged with each order (we are on our third shipment of this cuvée). If you love champagne, do yourself a flavor and stock up

The opposing lawyer (slicked back hair, pin striped suit, think Billy Bob Thornton as the Thin Man) leaps up, objecting wildly: "I object wildly! You people are focusing on vintages too young to have relevance in this case. May I enter into evidence the 1966 and 1970 Pichon-Lalande? I believe that the '66, spicy and solid in structure (and Château direct!) is compelling evidence, although of what I cannot say. The '70, crisp and cedary in the true claret style, is an absolutely lovely offering.

Atticus bolts from his chair and firmly protests: "I firmly protest! My client is too stupid to have committed the crime!" (As he speaks, **two children**, who have been sneaking toward the witness stand where Jim resides, leap up in unison and shout (we'll stay with the unison theme): "Boo!"

Jim: Yes, little kids?

Atticus: Scout! Jem! I told you not to leap in unison! (At that very moment—naturally—a rattling and clanking sound comes from the bench, where scores of Pichon-Lalande roll out onto the floor from underneath the robes of the startled judge!)

Atticus: The judge is the thief! Take him away!

Judge: The wine from Lalande was too delicious to resist! (He begins to sob uncontrollably).

Although I forgot the part about the rabid dog and the halloween scene, there are three lessons to be learned from *To Kill A Mocking Barr*: 1) The wines are great, 2) Jim "Boo" Barr really was too stupid, and 3) You can't book a judge by his blubber. —*Joe Zugelder*

On May 19th at 10:40 pm, while in Chris' arms, Rex took his last breath of life. He was an old Brittany, who had a wonderful life with miles of walks and hikes. I will miss his tail wagging each time I would get excited about a new wine discovery for this column. His ashes are buried in the upper part of the vineyard site that we feel will eventually produce what might be considered for our "Reserve" bottling, and will be known as "Rex's Corner Reserve." It is also the same corner Rex would immediately head for after our 3-hour trip from Redwood City to Anderson Valley. Get to Know 1996

A lot of the winemakers in champagne are very proud and excited about the 1996 vintage. With wonderful clean fruit, vibrant acidity and wound concentration being the common thread in the wines, they have a lot to be proud of. This vintage reminds me very much of the '88 vintage, and is certainly the best one to come along since 1990, and might even best it in the long run. The 1996 Ruelle-Pertois Grand Cru (\$29.99) is brand new to our stock and a great way to get to know the vintage without getting too much money out of your wallet. This is elegant, restrained champagne. The fruit is all Grand Cru from vineyards in Chouilly and all Chardonnay. The wine has a pale straw color and a slow, pin point carb. On the nose it has wonderful minerals and just a hint of macadamia like nuttiness. It is very dry and sophisticated on the palate; this is not an obvious wine that hits one over the head. It has a crisp, refreshing finish that begs for another sip. Just coming back into stock is the wildly popular **1996 Pierre Gimon**net "Gastronome" (\$29.99). This is a richer style that has a great creamy mid palate and good concentration. We sold out of our last 25 cases fast! We also have a "secret" 1996 Lallement Reserve (\$45.99). Although not labeled as such it is all from the 1996 vintage. It comes from a tiny ten-acre vineyard in Verzenay, the only north facing Grand Cru in France. Made of 80% pinot noir and 20% chardonnay, this champagne might be too much wine for some people, but if you are a fan of Krug and Bollinger, you must try it! Right now, in the middle of summer, we have some of the best Châteauneuf's available for the discerning palate and Rhône lover in us all! All of these 1999 Châteauneuf-du-Papes represent excellent quality and wonderful value.

The **Domaine Marcoux** (\$26.99) shows cherry and raspberry fruit in the nose with touches of cedar and spice. Viscous, sweet red fruits in the mouth with hints of anise on the finish. 90 points from Robert Parker. Will age for 12-14 years. Another gem on the list is the **Château Cabrières "Prestige"** (\$29.99). Black cherry and boysenberry fruit, minerals and spices in the nose. Rich on the palate, with plummy fruit, cinnamon and oak. 92 points from the *Wine Spectator* and 90 points from Robert Parker. Will age for 7-10 more years.

Third on our list is the **Château Maucoil "Privilege"** (\$29.99). Red raspberry and bing cherry fruit on a wonderful nose with ample oak. This is a slightly drier style with firm tannins overlaid with black pepper and plum fruit in the mouth. A favorite with our customers. Now for the heavy hitter. The **Château Beaucastel** (\$49.99) is a monster. The nose is full of generous oak and spice. The most traditional of the bunch, with dark, red cherry fruit, pepper, aromatic spices and just a hint of tobacco. This one is made for the long run. It's at its best when decanted. Last, but far from least, is a thoroughly pleasant wine in the guise of the **Château La Gardine**. A lovely wine, with a nose of black fruits and subtle vanilla. All of these selections are wonderful for the cellar and are at their best when given an hour's worth of breathing time or being decanted. If you do drink these soon, pair them with your favorite barbecued and grilled foods. Cheers and best wishes for a wonderful summer.

Pour Votre Plaisir

One of our favorite producers in Gevrey-Chambertin has been Domaine Heresztyn. Our friend Florence Heresztyn has returned to Burgundy after her 2 years here. She is working with her father on the winemaking, and her influence is already visible. The wines are much less rustic and more polished than they were just a few years ago and are more seamless and integrated. The 2000 Bourgogne Rouge (\$15.99) is less expensive than the 1999, and a wonderful soft, forward, bright cherry pinot noir. The 2000 Gevrey Chambertin, Vielles Vignes (\$31.99) also less than 1999, shows elegant bright pinot fruit, and structure and freshness-very appealing. Her **2000 Chambolle Musigny (\$36.99)** is described by Allen Meadows of Burghound.com as "Fresh, drop dead gorgeous pinot fruit and classy Chambolle elegance and finesse. This is not especially dense ... but wow, this is really fine and pretty." The 2000 Gevrey Chambertin, "Goulots", 1er Cru (\$42.99) has nice minerality and a very fine texture, and pretty black fruits, as you expect from this vineyard high on the hill. The 2000 Gevrey Chambertin, "Champonnets", 1er Cru (\$42.99) is denser than the other wines, from very old vines. The nose shows lots of fruit, and the palate has very good density and length. The 2000 Morey St Denis, "Les Millandes", 1er **Cru (\$56.99)** always my favorite of their premier Crus. It is bright, beautifully detailed and very pure. Finally the 2000 Clos St. Denis, **Grand Cru (\$74.99)** is described as "Plump and ripe, but full and concentrated too. Very good grip. This is stylish, long and complete. Very impressive. Lots of vigour, good ripe tannins. Very lovely classy finish. Fine Plus." (Clive Coates, The Vine)

Domaine Jean Marc and Hugues Pavelot is another domaine where the next generation is taking more of a role, and quality remains extraordinary. Their 2000s show very pure pinot fruit and great elegance and richness. We have the 2000 Savigny les Beaunes (\$24.99) which is succulent and round and the 2000 Pernand Vergelesses, "Les Vergelesses", 1er Cru (\$29.99) which is vibrant and fruit focused. The 2000 Savigny les Beaunes, "Peuillets", 1er Cru (\$29.99) is also round, with lovely fruit and more complexity, the 2000 Savigny les Beaunes, "Narbantons", 1er Cru (\$34.99) has elegance and finely focused flavors and great length and the 2000 Savigny les Beaunes, "Dominode", 1er Cru (\$34.99) which is deep and dark, with by far the most weight of the group. —Keith Wollenberg

Sotto la Pergola Inclinata

You usually don't find me writing about cabernet sauvignon or bordeaux blends under my pergola but we found a wine that is simply fabulous, and it's a blend of cabernet sauvignon, merlot and cabernet franc. Friuli-Venezia-Giulia the easternmost region in Italy lies just east of Venice leaning against the Slovenian and Croatian borders. It is home to many small wineries including one of our favorites, Ermacora. Most of the famous wines produced in Friuli (the everyday usage of Friuli-Venezia-Giulia) are white but over the past couple of decades the quality of reds has jumped considerably. Enter Teresa Raiz.

The 1999 Teresa Raiz "Decano Rosso" (\$24.99) is stunning. This bordeaux blend of cabernet sauvignon, merlot and cabernet franc is seamless. Layers of smoky chocolate, coupled with a black pepper laden, tobacco, gravel and spice-filled nose give way to a silky, ripe and long lasting finish. The wine has a character that reminds me of (apologies, Clyde) Graves, the famous wine growing region around the city of Bordeaux. The wine has power, ripeness and an easy drinkability now that belie its aging ability, which is easily 10+ years, when the wine will release all of its secrets. If you compare the quality of this wine at this price to what you get in California for this price you won't utter the word Napa again. This is a K&L exclusive. We continually pound the

back roads looking for high quality wine at great prices for and us! Every time I pour an Austrian wine for someone who has never had one before they are simply amazed. There is no country that is producing wine whose export quality is higher than Austria. We've just received a new shipment of some dazzling new dry whites! The 1999 Loimer Gruner Veltliner "Spiegel" (\$19.99) is extraordinary: white pepper permeates the air around you when you open the bottle, deliciously ripe and full on the palate. For a chardonnay alternative, try the deliciously ripe and intense 2000 Hiedler Gruner Veltliner "Thal" Novemberlese (\$20.99). 2000 Hirtzberger Gruner Velliner "Rotes Tor" Smaragd (\$32.99) is a reflection of one of the Wachau's greatest vineyards and stunning on the palate. The 2000 Hirsch Gruner Veltliner "Lamm" Alte Reben (\$22.99, 1.5L \$49.99) is power incarnate, dense, ripe and layers of soil, spice and fruit that will age for several decades, yes, you read that correctly, several decades, along with the 2000 Nigl Gruner Veltliner Piri Privat (1.5L \$64.99), outrageous quality. For dry riesling fans the 2000 vintage is SUPERB! The **2000 Salomon Riesling "Kogl" (\$17.99)**, 2000 Brundlmayer Riesling Heiligstein "Lyra" (\$39.99) and the 2000 Hirsch Riesling Gaisberg Alte Reben (\$29.99) are stunning.

Jeff's Picks: Leave Some Room for Riesling

Eric and I have returned from Germany safe and sound, bringing news of a truly special vintage. I was unprepared for how incredible the 2001 wines are. The weather pattern for the vintage was a very early bud break, cool dry weather in May and June, and disaster in September in the form of rain, but this was followed by an Indian summer—"Golden October" as the Germans call it—that lasted until mid November, allowing the grapes to shed some water and gain in maturity and acid structure. The resulting fruit was clean and pure, with very ripe fruit flavors and acidity and very little botrytis. The wines have depth and structure just seething with potential. As good as these puppies taste now it will be difficult to wait. The size of the crop in 2001 is even smaller than the miniscule 2000 vintage, and worldwide demand for this great vintage means there is not very much wine to go around. Some have sold out already. If ever there was a vintage to put in your cellar of gorgeous, vibrant riesling for the future, this is it. Quality is very fine from QBA on up. The wines show purity, vineyard character, structure and length unlike any young vintage most producers can remember. They are packed with fruit and minerals and just linger on the palate forever. Just open a bottle of 2001 Josef Leitz Drachenstein Riesling QBA (\$13.99) and you will see what this vintage has in store: bright juicy fruit flavors mingled with spice and earth, apricot and grapefruit, with a little more definition of flavor than the 2000 and richer body.
