### 1999 Lancaster Alexander Valley Red .....\$49.99

The 1999 Lancaster is a complex, layered wine, revealing concentrated currant and black plum notes, a graceful texture, and a polished finish. With a high percentage of merlot in 1999, this wine is very approachable right now.

### 2000 Lewis Cellars Napa Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon .....\$69.99

One of the best of the vintage. 92-94 points from the Wine Spectator 'Dark, rich and elegant, with anise- and cedar-laced currant and black cherry. Finishes long and focused, with mild tannins.'

### 1999 Quintessa Rutherford Cabernet Sauvignon .....\$84.99

Great wine from a great vintage. The wine shows intense red berry and cassis flavors, minerals, cedar and ripe tannins on the finish. It should develop well in a cellar over the next 5-10 years. The 1999 is a blend of 75% cabernet sauvignon, 20 % merlot and 5% cabernet franc."

### 1989 Château Gruaud Larose, St-Julien .....\$59.99

91 points from the *Wine Spectator* in May of '99, "Brilliant and youthful raspberry color. Subtle aromas of raspberries and spices. Full-bodied, with firm tannins and long, silky-textured, minty, berry finish."

### 1993 Château Cos d'Estournel, St-Estèphe .....\$49.99

Robert Parker says, "One of the most successful Médoc's of the vintage, Cos d'Estournel's 1993 exhibits an opaque dark purple color, and a heady, sweet, pure, blackcurrant bouquet that roars from the glass. With surprising richness, fat, and glycerin, tasters would never suspect that this is medium-bodied, elegant yet authoritatively-flavored wine."

### 1994 Château Pichon-Lalande, Pauillac .....\$64.99

91-93 points from Parker, "The dark ruby/purple color is followed by a captivating nose of sweet, jammy red and black fruits, vanilla, caramel, and spice. Medium to full-bodied, with a sweet mid-palate crammed with fruit, this beautifully-textured, voluptuous wine possesses superb concentration, outstanding balance, and a long, rich finish . . . To put it in the context of other recent Pichon-Lalande vintages, it is richer than the 1988 and 1985!"

### 1994 Château Léoville-Barton, St-Julien (1.5L) .....\$79.99

91 points from Robert Parker, "The 1994 continues to be a classic Léoville-Barton. . . The wine possesses an impressively dense, opaque ruby/purple color, as well as a strikingly intense nose of cedar, vanilla, ripe blackcurrants, and spice. Full-bodied, structured, powerful, and muscular, this is the consummate textbook example of a top-notch St-Julien that is meant for long-term cellaring, yet has enough appeal and sweetness of fruit to be drunk at an earlier age."

## Bubbly for the Summer

### Philipponnat "Royal Reserve" Brut .....\$24.99

The house of Philipponnat is neighbors with Billecart-Salmon in Mareuil-sur-Ay in the heart of Champagne. This wine is a big, toasty, yeasty wine made mostly from pinot noir. It is made from 45% pinot noir, 35% chardonnay and 20% meunier from vineyards on the mountain of Reims, the Côtes de Blancs and the valley of the Marne.

### 1996 Ariston Vintage Brut .....\$29.99

This is the best '96 I have tasted yet, from anyone. Paul-Vincent Ariston decided to hold this wine and leave it on the yeast even longer than Roederer held back their Cristal! The wine has a purity of pinot noir fruit and a rare focus that reminds me of Volnay on the nose. In the mouth, it is bright and light without lacking concentration. It is just plain complete! The low price does not make one bit of sense, but I am not going to argue for a higher one! -Gary Westby

### Ariston Aspasia Brut Prestige .....\$29.99

This champagne is made from the oldest (50 to 60 years!) vines of this small 25-acre property. It has incredible old vine density, a serious and powerful character that reminds me of the fantastically rare and expensive Bollinger Ay Villes Vignes. The cuvée is 40% chardonnay, 30% pinot noir, and 30% meunier. The red fruit dominates. A masculine, rich style that finishes forever and still refreshes.

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## The More Things Change . . .

the more they stay the same. I was looking back on two of our first newsletters (Spring 1980, vol 2, no 1 and Spring 1983, vol 4, no 1) and I had to chuckle at the editorials I wrote. In the 1980 issue, the article was titled "And the Prices Keep Rising!" I was bemoaning the fact that imported wine prices were increasing rapidly, mainly because the dollar was so weak—at about 4.5 francs to the dollar, much weaker than the current \$1.2 per Euro). I ended by saying "our advice to our customers concerning stocking their cellars is to be careful with the imports and search out good California buys." There were still bargains from all sources, e.g. 1977 Grahams Port at \$12, 1976 Sassicaia at \$10.95, and 1975 Silver Oak Cab at \$11.50. In the 1983 issue, the article was titled "The Times Have Changed." Well, the dollar was over 7 francs (it went to 10F in 1985) and our advice was just the opposite, as California wineries were raising their prices each year. Again, there were many bargains to be had, e.g. 1981 Pichon Lalande (\$11.75), Veuve Clicquot Brut (\$15.50), and 1978 BV Private Reserve (\$13.75) Well now, twenty years later, the dollar is quite weak, some California wineries are still raising their prices, and there are still bargains galore from all over the world. This newsletter is full of superb values including all 2001 and 2002 Bordeaux wines, the 2001 German wines, and the myriad of Spanish and Aussie wines at under \$15. Also, throw in a ton of great bubblys, California gems, and Italian values.

In short, no matter what the economic conditions are, it's always a buyer's market when it comes to buying fine wine from K&L! —*Clyde Beffa, Jr*

While these wines may have their place in the market, we don't feel that you can learn anything from them. We continue to find the best values for our club members, as well as find wines of interest and high quality from around the world.

### 2001 Kevin Arnold Shiraz Waterford Estate, Stellenbosch, South Africa (\$32.99)

The Waterford Estate is located in the Helderberg mountain range in the Stellenbosch, and is owned by the Ord and Arnold families. Kevin Arnold, is the winemaker who worked at Delheim for 9 years and Rust en Vrede for 10 years, efforts that earned him wines in the *Wine Spectator's* Top 100 three years in a row. The Waterford is 100% cabernet that spends 17 months in 55% French and 45% American oak and has a bouquet that sings with dark plum and currants, with notes of violet

## Let the Corks Fly in July!

We all spend a lot of time searching out the great wines and great wine deals. It sure is nice to kick back, take a few deep breaths and drink some of them. I really enjoy the summer months, serving wine out-of-doors at parties, or just savoring a quiet glass of chilled Sancerre (2001 Franck Millet, of course, at 10.99). The relaxing atmosphere with family and friends always accelerates the fun, and the number of bottles tasted! I like to serve my guests a wide array of wines, and my next gathering will go something like this:

For starters, it's the above-mentioned Millet Sancerre. Pure strong sauvignon blanc, no wood, very limey and crisp, lovely balance, the wine really shines.

Once everyone is at the table, we serve a very small, slightly chilled pour of sauternes in a small glass to start the meal. 1999 Suduiraut Sauternes (\$29.99) will be perfect, sweet and lush, to go with the foie gras on toast. The white wine glasses are ready to go, and after a quick move to the barbecue, the jumbo shrimp is served with a chilled bottle of Château Bouscaut Blanc (\$15.99) from the fantastic 1998 vintage in the Graves. The wine is in full expression of its richly styled Semillon, with tart green apple from sauvignon blanc and a round, creamy feel from the oak.

With the mixed grill of veggies, sausages, chicken, and beef, I make my guest work a bit. Everyone wants to taste what's hot, so I'm going to splash tasting size pours of two newly arrived 2000 Bordeaux. First, will be the forward and fruity style of Château Bois Martin, Graves. Made by our friend Anthony Perrin, the owner of Château Carbonnieux, it's fresh and effusive, with strawberry and cherries on the palate, So very tasty for \$16.99; it is already a big hit.

My next wine needs no introduction. To celebrate the 2000 vintage, the picture of the Comtesse herself Virginie Comtesse de Lalande, who had the Château built in 1840 now adorns the label and the capsule is golden. 2000 Reserve de la Comtesse (\$24.99) drew absolute rave reviews at the tasting bars in May. This wine will not last long, so buy it ASAP, taste one bottle and stick the rest in the cellar.

1999 Château Bernadotte (\$14.99) will carry us through the rest of the main course at a relaxing pace. Owned and managed by Pichon-Longueville Comtesse de Lalande, it is the same style wine, soft, round and delicious and made to drink young. With the peach/pear tarte we bring back our old pal 1999 Suduiraut for another splash. Then it's wave goodbye and good night. and pencil lead. These elements follow on the palate with very good balance and fine tannins leading to a long finish with a hint of mint and light earthy note. Kevin Arnold makes his own shiraz at the estate, that sees 12 months in 60% American and 40% French oak, and that offers juicy and concentrated black fruits with blueberry high notes framed by toasty oak.

### 2000 Penfolds Bin 407 Cabernet Sauvignon, Australia (\$19.99)

With all the boutique wineries that exist, you sometimes can over look the "big boys", but you have to hand it to Penfolds for the incredible range of wines they offer. The "bin numbers" are wines that are moderately priced, with the exception of the Bin 707, which is at a higher price. Well, in 2000 there was no Bin 707 made and it seems some of the juice has made its way into the Bin 407. The nose shows ripe red currant and mulberry with notes of cedar, tobacco, chocolate and mint. On the palate there is good acidity with fine tannins and very good length.

### 2001 Hill of Content Grenache-Shiraz, Clare Valley-McLaren Vale, Australia (Inquire)

Here's a great value made from 83% grenache from the Clare Valley and 17% shiraz from McLaren Vale. This wine shows the classic character of these two grape varieties with the grenache offering effusive aromatics of ripe black raspberry with white pepper notes and the shiraz adding dark plum and berry giving backbone to the structure.

## Trey's Corner!

True or false: Caymus Vineyards currently produces pinot noir.  
 Answer: True. They do make a pinot noir but it's not under the Caymus label. The **2001 Belle Glos Pinot Noir (\$29.99)** represents the first release of pinot noir from Caymus in over 10 years. Belle Glos fruit comes from a 75-acre vineyard in the Santa Maria Valley. The vineyard is on a west facing slope just 13 miles from the ocean, which helps create fruit with elegance, balance and crisp acidity. Planted in 1972, yeilds are kept very low (1.6 tons per acre) and the berries are very small and concentrated. This wine is fresh, lively, silky and delicate. The 60% new oak gives the wine just a hint of oak and spice. Be on the lookout for other releases of pinot noir under this label. If you are a fan of Cabernet than I highly recommend you taste the **1999 Lancaster Estate Alexander Vally Cabernet Sauvignon (\$49.99)**. Lancaster is 100 percent estate-grown fruit from their 53 acre hillside property located at the southern tip of the Alexander Valley. The 1999 is a blend of 59% merlot, 40% cabernet sauvignon and 1% cabernet franc. The 1999 is delicious right now. The high percentage of Merlot gives this wine a fleshy, silky mouth-feel. Flavors include crushed red berries, vanilla, anise, spicy herbs and black currants. On May 29th I had the opportunity to attend the grand opening of the Quintessa Winery in Napa. Not only can Quintessa make one heck of a Cabernet they can also throw one heck of a party. If you are in Napa this summer I would recommend trying to make an appointment to visit the winery. Since it is July I need to mention at least one white wine. My Chardonnay pick for this month is the **2000 Franciscan "Cuvée Sauvage" Chardonnay (\$27.99)**. This has always been a favorite of mine. It shows flavors of butterscotch, spice, citrus and vanilla. It's what we call a pool-side sipper! —Trey Belfa

Dark fruits, coffee, mocha and licorice flavors highlight this balanced and full bodied zinfandel. Very small production.

**2001 Lucia "Gary's Vineyard" Santa Lucia Pinot Noir (\$32.99)** This highly anticipated new label from Pisoni Vineyards shows a big, dense, but open texture with flavors of spice, dark berry and minerals.

**2001 Elk Cove Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon (\$16.99)** This wine shows tons of ripe cherry fruit, minerals, sweet leather, and spice, which is followed by a soft generous finish. One of my favorites.

**2001 Chehalem 3 Vineyards Pinot Noir, Oregon (\$19.99)** This wine shows ripe fruit complimented with minerals, sweet herbs and spice.

**2000 Hermitage "La Sizeranne," Chapoutier (\$54.99)** Lovers of Rhône wines will surely recognize this famous northern Rhône producer. Massive yet supple, this wine has it all. Ripe, black plummy fruit, chocolate and toasty oak make this wine a classic. Very balanced with a very long, intense finish. 94 points from the *Wine Spectator*. Will age for up to 20 more years. 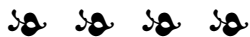

# Famous Composers: Ludwig von Beethoven

(1770-1827)

This is a history of one of the most famous and influential composers in modern history—Ludwig von Beethoven. Despite an unbelievably lazy streak, he was to compose more than ten thousand works, including nine thousand one note symphonies. “The Nine Grand,” as these works were known, were performed in one afternoon, setting the *Guinness Book of World Records* for compositions played in one day. He did not hear the applause of the audience at the finale not because he was deaf—that would come later—but because the audience was asleep.

Beethoven was many things throughout his life, and was not many things as well. In the early years, his compositions were restrained and somewhat bland, as evidenced by the works “Komm Gib Mir Deine Hand” (I Want to Hold Your Hand) and “L’Orgue Accidentale” (the Organ Accident). Probably the most memorable work of this period was “Le Cornemuse Faible Mal Accorde” (The Weak Out-of-Tune Accordion). The crying in the score was performed by the Vienna Boys Choir after learning they would sing backup to the dreaded instrument.

A lover of fine wine, Beethoven was entranced by the nuances of **Pichon-Lalande**, in particular the **1989** vintage, which at this stage is showing a bit more cedar, saddle leather, and earthy qualities as the fruit comes into balance. Medium in body with the vanilla and ripe cherry flavors the Château is known for, the wine is perfect now—a far cry from the work of Beethoven, for whom the sophomore jinx had certainly hit. His work suffered as his hearing began to fail, putting him in danger of being both deaf AND dumb. He continued to drink fine wine; the full bodied cabernet profile of the **1983 Latour** reminded him of his public persona—backward, slow to evolve, slightly dumb early on, but gaining weight and complexity with age. Beethoven secretly hoped that he could perform as well. His collaboration with Mozart, “Le Cloche de Vache Diminue” (The Half Diminished Cowbell) was his most adventurous piece during this period.



Reduced to sign language, Beethoven continued to write in this final phase of his life, when the composer finally achieved the greatness that was previously only hinted at. The Excedrin commercial (Beethoven’s Ninth) is certainly the most famous. Little known trivia: Vincent van Gogh was such a fan of Beethoven that he cut off his OTHER ear and mailed it the composer in the hopes that this would restore Beethoven’s hearing. A postal mishap ended with the ear going to van Gogh’s wine-loving girlfriend and a bottle of **1994 Léoville-Las-Cases** going to the composer. This at least gave Beethoven the pleasure of a bold, concentrated wine with ripe black fruits and heady tannins, all in wonderful balance. It also was the origin of the phrase “lend me your ear.” Van Gogh tried in vain to recover the ear but his girlfriend wouldn’t hear of it. Two ears, she said, were better than one.

Beethoven’s passing left a larger void than his personality; thousands lined the streets to pay him homage. To this day, accordion jokes still dominate Catskills comedy clubs. He will live forever.

## Jim’s Rara Avis July Gems

After literally having one of the coldest, wettest springs in recent memory, the weather turned warm two weekends ago on May 24th; and vines in the north coast have responded dramatically with canes seeming to grow three to four inches per day. The first critical stage of this vintage is upon us with the new clusters now beginning to flower. It looks very optimistic, so stay tuned

I feel a need to mention that our last shipment of **2001 Kalinda Sauvignon Blanc, Lake County (\$7.99)** has arrived. Its evolution in the bottle the last several months have made this wonderfully dry, crisp, refreshing, non-oaked white a wine that you need to seriously consider. Its fig- to grapefruit-like characteristics cause it to be the perfect wine to have with shellfish or as a cocktail, which is the way Ebby and I have treated it. (🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷)

Another great buy is the **1998 Rene Manuel Bourgogne Blanc (\$7.99)**. Produced from vineyards that lie at the base of the Premier vineyards of Meursault, it is rather Meursault-like in its presentation, with a subtle richness backed by firm acid structure and toasty tones, the flavors offer a lovely integration of white peach- to pear-like fruit with just a touch of white blossoms to finish it off. This was meant to sell for \$15.99 and should have, except that it was lost in the sea of wine that has accumulated domestically. Keith was able to negotiate a great deal. (🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷)

From **Purisima Canyon**, we have one of the best Cabernet deals of the year. The **2000 Cabernet Sauvignon, North Coast (\$8.99)** is deep ruby in color, provides opulent aromas of cassis to currant fruit underscored by cedary oak. In the mouth, it is full, nicely structured, perfectly balanced between the hint of oak, soft tannins, and deep, warm fruit. The finish seems to last forever. Anderson has informed me that this will be our house red for the month. (🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷)

One of the best business moves that Clyde and Todd ever made was to hire Greg St Clair a few years ago, not only as our General Manager, but as our guide into a wine area in which we were weak: Italian wines. He has turned us onto, force fed us so much information, and so educated us about the wines of Italy that at times it leaves my little brain spinning. One of his discoveries several years back while on a buying trip to Italy was the wines of Badia di Morrona. The **2000 Sodi del Paretaio Chianti Superiore (\$8.99)** is a bright, fleshy, well-structured wine that is the perfect wine for any pasta dish, particularly one with a red sauce. So, Anderson: how would you feel about having two house reds for the month? (🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷)

One of my favorite Champagnes in our stock is one of our most reasonably priced, the **De Meric Grande Reserve Sous Bois Brut Champagne (\$24.99)**. It is from one of our very smallest producers: they make a little less than 5000 cases a year total. They have a great slogan "There are numerous modern techniques used in Champagne today—we ignore them all." They still use the traditional vertical press and vinify in oak. The **Reserve Sous Bois** is fermented half in barrel with no malolactic and half in stainless steel with malolactic, making a perfectly balanced and textured bottle of Champagne. It is composed of 80% pinot noir from Ay, Mareuil-sur-Ay and Mutigny, 15% chardonnay from Cramant, Avize and Oger and 5% meunier from Cumières. In a big style, it has plenty of toasty complexity but also an elegant, small bead. If you like Champagne, you should try this one. Don't let the low price fool you, we've eliminated all the courtiers, export brokers, import companies, and distributors mark-ups to bring this to you at direct pricing! ## Loire: Summertime and Sauvignon Blanc

As the days grow longer and the weather warmer, I am reminded of how much I love this wine. It embodies everything I hope to be this season. Snappy, sexy, and fun, with just enough substance to keep things "real". Drinking a glass of sauvignon blanc always inspires me to eat better, exercise more, and run through sprinklers. I am particularly enamored with the wines of Pouilly and Sancerre. Here, in France's Loire Valley, sauvignon blanc finds its unique expression, as a high degree of silex frequently imparts a flinty  *pierre à fusil*  element to the wines. In the hands of a great producer these wines are polished terroir-driven examples of the varietal. The **2001 Cherrier & Fils Sancerre (\$11.99)** is one such example. Fresh lime, kiwi, and honeydew are balanced by a profound minerality. A very lithe and racy wine indeed. The **2001 Caves Jean Grothe Pouilly-Fumé Acacia (\$19.99)** displays a bit more *rondeur* on the palate. Nectarine, grapefruit and honeysuckle are grounded by just a hint of earthiness on the finish. This is simply gorgeous wine. ### Pour Votre Plaisir

#### Sumertime Whites

It's summertime, and the livin' is easy. Fish are jumpin' and you need some summer sipping wines. Let me suggest a few for you.

One of the wines that has become one of our customers' favorites is the **Plaisir des Princes (\$5.99)**. It's declassified **2001 Macon**, but at an amazingly attractive price. Chardonnay—crisp and clean, with no oak but charm and a bit of minerality. All for \$5.99? We have been waiting anxiously for this shipment to arrive. Only our direct import can make this possible with the dollar so weak compared to the Euro. Stock up now, because we may not be able to hold this price for the next shipment.

Another bargain is the **2001 St Veran, Domaine JP Dutron, (\$9.99)**. This is clean, focused chardonnay, with pronounced minerality and a lovely citrus note on the nose. It's another great value for summer sipping. It has nice richness, but avoids the fat, buttery style that seems less refreshing this time of year. And, of course, the **1998 Bourgogne Chardonnay, René Manuel (\$7.99)** is rich, elegant chardonnay, with notes of pear and apple, a bit of Meursault minerality, and crisp acidity. While it lasts, it's a great bargain.

For more serious drinking, we were very pleased to find more of the **2000 Corton Charlemagne, Grand Cru, Bonneau de Martray (\$74.99)**. Martray hit the ball completely out of the ball park with this one! It is, quite simply, the best Corton I have ever tasted from this Domaine, and they are always one of my favorites. Rovani, writing in Parker's *Wine Advocate* scores it 94+ points and says: "Shame on me! I vastly under-rated this estate's Corton-Charlemagne in my barrel assessment a year ago (originally scored 88-90) . . . it has superb focus, detail and seamlessness. Toast, spices, pears, and ripe apples can be found throughout its complex character. If this wine continues to improve in bottle as it did in the final months of élevage, it will be completely mind-boggling." Once again, we see the perils of believing that a single rating, done at a single moment, can tell you all that there is to know about Burgundy. The good news is that the living, breathing wines of Burgundy continue to surprise and amaze. Drink some yourself, and you will see why. *A santé* —Keith Wollenberg

### Sotto la Pergola Inclinata

Is 2002 a disaster of a vintage? You all saw the pictures and heard the news and reports of the disastrous floods and devastating hail storms in Italy last summer. Well, no, that isn't exactly accurate. Yes, there were horrible hailstorms in Barolo and along the shores of Lake Garda and there won't be any "Brunate" Barolo for 2002, but there will be wine from other vineyards. 2002 will end the 6-year streak of great Barolo/Barbaresco vintages making good nearer term wines, but it is one of the best vintages ever for the Alto Adige, excellent for Friulian whites but with drastic quantity reductions. Coastal southern Tuscany was very good too. Selection will be the key, there will be very good wines but supply will be down.

A few new arrivals to liven up your summer 2001 Poggio alle Sughere Morellino di Scansano (\$12.99). Sangiovese from the south Tuscan coast that has big, powerful fruit, muscular structure, it's a whole lot of wine for the money, like a bargain Brunello! 2001 Il Poggiolo Barco Reale (\$13.99) from just outside of Florence is an exuberant blend of sangiovese and cabernet that will thrill you. Forward, soft fruit, luscious on the palate—a real easy drinker! It will become your go to wine. 1997 Trabucchi Valpolicella Superiore (\$27.99), this wine sends me reeling from the aromas, middle eastern spice, rich, plum-

my fruit, that engulf the senses, soft and easy on the palate it is a wine to drink now through the next 3-4 years. For starters try the Col Sandago Prosecco (\$12.99), a drier, crisp and ultimately refreshing style of Venice's favorite sparkler! The 1999 Castello di Lucignano Chianti Classico Riserva (\$29.99) comes from an exceptional vintage and is an exceptional wine, a complex blend of ripe fruit and spicy aromatics and a super long finish. Lucignano sits just up the road from its famous neighbor San Giusto a Rentennano in southern Gaiole. The 1999 Consorzio Produttori Velletri Riserva (\$13.99) hails from the Castelli Romani just outside of Rome and is a blend of cesanese, merlot, sangiovese and montepulciano, full of plum, cocoa, leather, middle eastern spices and a very supple wine on the palate, wonderful to drink now or age for another 3-5 years. The 1999 Abbazia di Novacella "Praepositus" Lagrein (\$37.99) is flat out awesome. Lagrein for those of you who aren't familiar is an indigenous grape variety from the Alto Adige with genetic ancestry from Syrah. The Abbey's top of the line Lagrein shows spicy, peppery highlights over the top of the dense blueberry-like fruit, while layers of roasted coffee and smoke intertwines through the thick, rich and supple body.

From one of my favorite wineries Cantina Terlan, in the Alto Adige, this year's **2000 Vorberg-Pinot Bianco (\$19.99)** is perfect for warm summer days. The wine is pale yellow with green reflexes. On the nose, I get intense green apples & pears combined with delicate woody nuances. The palate is medium-bodied, with a gentle, soft acidity and a long lingering finish.

The **Poggio Alle Sughere 2001 Morellino di Scansano (\$12.99)** is a wonderful new release. At this year's Vinality, we discovered some great '01s from Tuscany. This Morellino has very pretty aromas of blackberries and cherries. Medium-bodied, with dark fruit, polished tannins and a hint of coffee on the finish. These last two wines, which Greg and I tasted in April at Vinality, are from Ca de Medici. I have been anxiously waiting their arrival since. The **Lambrusco Reggiano Rosso (\$7.99)** is frizzante with a touch of strawberries and wild flowers on the palate, without being too sweet. The **Terra Calda Rosso (\$9.99)** is also frizzante and slightly off dry. The production of this wine is very limited—from old vine Lambrusco. The wine is dark ruby in color on the froth, with wonderful blackberries and plum in the mouth. Give both of these wines a slight chill and enjoy the days of summer.

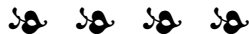

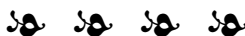

Like no previous vintage, 2001 has grabbed the attention not only of the wine press, sommeliers and buyers like myself but of you—the people who spend your hard earned dollars to drink fun, exciting wines. If 2002 had turned out less exciting, all the enthusiasm would have been lost, and the unique and expressive wines of Germany would have faded into the background again. Fear not, my friends, the hallmark of 2002 is a purity and openness of fruit so clear and expressive you may wonder if there is some fresh-squeezed juice in every bottle. The acid structure is ripe and, in most cases, similar to 2001. These are classic wines, elegant and racy, serene and expressive. The Rheingau, Pfalz, Ruwer and Saar have turned out examples that definitely surpass their 2001 counterparts. The **2002 Josef Leitz Rudesheimer Klosterlay Spätlese (\$18.99)** is a special bottling available only at K&L. A masterful Spätlese, balancing the effusive fruit character of the vintage with bright, lively acidity, gorgeous aromas of spiced apple, apricot and vanilla dominate the nose.
